A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a construction contract with Ronyak Paving, Inc., for the 2020 Summit County 422 Resurfacing Program, in an amount not to exceed \$363,076.00 (for a cumulative increase of 50.3%), for a total amount not to exceed \$1,084,857.05, for the County Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2019-452, which authorized the County Executive to advertise as needed for bridge engineering and construction projects and pavement maintenance projects, for the County Engineer's 2020 Capital Improvements Program, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$5,290,750.00; and

WHEREAS, following the receipt and review of bids, the County Executive proposed entering into a construction contract with Ronyak Paving, Inc., for the 2020 Summit County 422 Resurfacing Program, in an amount not to exceed \$721,781.05; and

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-104, which confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Ronyak Paving, Inc., for the 2020 Summit County 422 Resurfacing Program, in an amount not to exceed \$721,781.05, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, the City of New Franklin, which joined the County's 422 Regional Resurfacing Program, has adopted a resolution authorizing the City to pay for the alternates that were part of the bid package and resurface additional roads, which requires a change order to the original contract; and

WHEREAS, Change Order No. 1 to the aforementioned contract will be in an amount not to exceed \$363,076.00 (for a cumulative increase of 50.3%), to be entirely paid by the City; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held July 8, 2020, awarded said Change Order No. 1; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information. that the aforementioned Change Order No. 1 to the construction contract with Ronyak Paving, Inc. for a total amount not to exceed \$1,084,857.05, is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;
