A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute a grant agreement with the Summa Hospital Foundation in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00, to expand the Summa Health Centering Program into underserved areas of the County for the period from 8/1/20 through 5/31/22, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution Nos. 2019-332 and 2019-361, this Council authorized the Executive to settle any or all claims, and to execute any corresponding settlement agreements and any necessary related documents, in litigation titled *In re: National Prescription Opiate Litigation*, Case No. 1:17-MD-2804, before Judge Dan Aaron Polster in the United States District Court, Northern District of Ohio (the "Lawsuit"), with any manufacturing or distributor Defendants, regardless of market share of the opioid market in Summit County and to additionally authorize settlement with any pharmacy Defendants; and

WHEREAS, the County has received monies as a result of settlement of the Lawsuit; and

WHEREAS, through a settlement in the Lawsuit, Defendant Johnson & Johnson agreed to pay \$2,000,000.00 to Centering Programs in Summit County, such programs being operated by Akron General Cleveland Clinic/Axess Pointe and Summa Health, so that each operator received \$1,000,000.00; and

WHEREAS, Summa Health, which has operated a Centering Program for several years, seeks to expand their program into underserved areas of the County and has need of an additional \$500,000.00 in order to fully fund such expansion, including expansion of the program for pregnant opiate addicted women incarcerated at the Summit County Jail; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute a grant agreement with the Summa Hospital Foundation in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00 from settlement dollars received by the County in the Lawsuit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The Executive is hereby authorized to execute a grant agreement with the Summa Hospital Foundation in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00, to expand their Centering Program for the period from 8/1/20 through 5/31/22 using funds from the settlements received in litigation titled *In re: National Prescription Opiate Litigation*, Case No. 1:17-MD-2804, before Judge Dan Aaron Polster in the United States District Court, Northern District of Ohio.

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SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that the County wishes to immediately provide support to the Summa Health Centering Program through a grant to the Summa Hospital Foundation.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the County Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
