7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a fifth renewal of a purchase**  
8 **contract with Aramark Correctional Services, LLC, as a Best Practical Source, for food**  
9 **services at the Jail, for a one-year term, from 12/1/20 through 11/30/21, in a total amount**  
10 **not to exceed \$800,000.00, for the Executive and the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2015-458, which confirmed  
13 an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Aramark Correctional Services,  
14 LLC (“Aramark”) to provide food services at the Jail and Glenwood Jail, for a one-year term,  
15 from 12/1/15 through 11/30/16, with four options to renew for an additional one-year term, in a  
16 total amount not to exceed \$700,000.00; and

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18 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2018-360, which changed  
19 the designation of the Glenwood Jail to a Community Alternative Sentencing Center and as a  
20 result, relieved the County from the responsibility of providing food services to said facility; and

22 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2019-461, which confirmed  
23 the award by the Board of Control of a renewal (fourth and final) of the purchase contract with  
24 Aramark to provide food services at the Jail, for a one-year term, from 12/1/19 through 11/30/20,  
25 in a total amount not to exceed \$800,000.00; and

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27 WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic has required the  
28 Sheriff’s Office to limit all but necessary personnel at the Jail in accordance with guidelines  
29 issued by the Ohio Department of Health; and

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31 WHEREAS, due to the aforementioned limitations, it is impractical and unsafe to  
32 advertise for bids for a purchase contract for food services at the Jail, as it would require  
33 potential bidders to visit the Jail, which is not permitted; and

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35 WHEREAS, due to its past experience is providing food services at the Jail, Aramark is  
36 a Best Practical Source to continue as the County’s vendor and Aramark has agreed to supply  
37 food at the current price per meal during an additional renewal term; and

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39 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held July 29, 2020, awarded a fifth  
40 renewal of a purchase contract with Aramark, as a Best Practical Source, for food services at the  
41 Jail, for a one-year term, from 12/1/20 through 11/30/21, in a total amount not to exceed  
42 \$800,000.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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44 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
45 that the fifth renewal of the aforementioned purchase contract with Aramark is necessary and in  
46 the best interest of the County of Summit;

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48 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

6 The award by the Board of Control of a fifth renewal of a purchase contract with  
7 Aramark Correctional Services, LLC for food services at the Jail, for a one-year term, from  
8 12/1/20 through 11/30/21, in a total amount not to exceed \$800,000.00, is hereby confirmed and  
9 the Executive is hereby authorized to execute such purchase contract and any other necessary  
10 related documents.

12 SECTION 2

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14 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
15 welfare of the residents of Summit County, and for the further reason to immediately provide for  
16 food services at the Jail from 12/1/20 through 11/30/21.

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18 SECTION 3


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20 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
21 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
22 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

30 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


