7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to issue rebate payments to communities with**
8 **which the Sheriff has a policing contract, in lieu of County of Summit Payroll Support**
9 **Program payments, in an amount not to exceed \$632,047.69, declaring such expenditure**
10 **necessary due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019**
11 **(COVID-19), for the Executive and the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, this Council, through Res. No. 2020-180 created the County of Summit
14 COVID-19 Local Government Payroll Support Grant Program (“Program”) and authorized the
15 Executive to execute Payroll Support Grant Agreements with all of the communities within
16 Summit County, in order to share the funding received by the county pursuant to and in
17 compliance with the provisions of section 5001 of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and
18 Economic Security Act, to be used to cover the expenses of public safety and public health
19 employees; and

21 WHEREAS, certain communities within the County obtain their policing services from
22 the Sheriff by way of Policing Contracts, and thus would not have qualifying positions on their
23 payroll to enable them to receive the benefit of the Program; and

25 WHEREAS, in such situations, it is the Sheriff who will use the Program Funds and will
26 otherwise receive the benefit from the Program; and

27
28 WHEREAS, the Executive desires to provide rebates of contract payments made by the
29 communities of the City of Green, and the Townships of Coventry, Northfield Center and
30 Twinsburg, in an amount equal to the benefit received by the Sheriff, of Program Funds; and

32 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information
33 that the aforementioned rebates of contract payments in an amount not to exceed \$632,047.69 are
34 necessary in order for the communities of the City of Green, and the Townships of Coventry,
35 Northfield Center and Twinsburg to realize the benefit from the Program;

37 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
38 of Ohio, that:

40 SECTION 1

42 The Executive is hereby authorized to issue rebates, in an amount not to exceed
43 \$632,047.69, to the communities the City of Green (\$300,000.00), and the Townships of Coventry
44 (\$82,500.00), Northfield Center (\$167,257.32) and Twinsburg (\$82,290.37) and any documents
45 necessary to effectuate such rebates.

47 SECTION 2

49 This Council finds and declares that the expenditure of \$632,047.69 to provide rebates to
50 said communities is necessary so they may realize the benefit they would have received pursuant
51 to the County of Summit COVID-19 Local Government Payroll Support Grant Program

6 This Resolution is declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
7 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately
8 authorize the County to provide rebates to the above listed Summit County political subdivisions
9 who have been adversely affected by the COVID-19 pandemic so that the same can maintain the
10 safety of their communities at a level necessary to effectively respond to the pandemic.

14 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
15 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
16 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

20 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
21 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
22 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were
23 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
24 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


