7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**
8 **Republic Services of Ohio Hauling LLC, for the disposal of sludge from the Fishcreek**
9 **Wastewater Treatment Plant #25, located in the City of Stow, in Council District 3, to a**
10 **solid waste landfill in Dover, Ohio, in an amount not to exceed \$107,730.00, for the**
11 **Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-185, which authorized
14 the Executive to advertise for bids for the disposal of sludge from both the Fishcreek Wastewater
15 Treatment Plant ("WWTP") #25, located in the City of Stow, and the Upper Tuscarawas WWTP
16 #36, located in Springfield Township, in Council Districts 3 and 8, respectively, to a solid waste
17 landfill, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$180,000.00; and

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19 WHEREAS, the County selected Republic Services of Ohio Hauling LLC ("Republic
20 Services") as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the Fishcreek WWTP #25; and

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22 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held August 12, 2020, awarded a
23 purchase contract with Republic Services, for the disposal of sludge from the Fishcreek WWTP
24 #25 to a solid waste landfill in Dover, Ohio, in an amount not to exceed \$107,730.00, subject to
25 confirmation by this Council; and

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27 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
28 that the aforementioned purchase contract with Republic Services is necessary and in the best
29 interest of the County of Summit;

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31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
32 of Ohio, that:

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34 SECTION 1

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36 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Republic Services of Ohio
37 Hauling LLC, for the disposal of sludge from the Fishcreek Wastewater Treatment Plant #25,
38 located in the City of Stow, in Council District 3, to a solid waste landfill in Dover, Ohio, in an
39 amount not to exceed \$107,730.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized
40 to execute such purchase contract and any other necessary related documents.

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42 SECTION 2

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44 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare
45 of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide for
46 the removal and disposal of sludge in the City of Stow.

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48 SECTION 3

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50 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
51 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
52 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
