7 **A Resolution certifying delinquent Surface Water Management District charges to the**
8 **Fiscal Officer, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

9
10 WHEREAS, the billing records at the Engineer's office show delinquent surface water
11 utility accounts which represent unpaid charges; and

12
13 WHEREAS, Section 942.07(d) of the County of Summit Codified Ordinances provides
14 that these charges are to be certified to the Fiscal Officer and placed on the real property tax list
15 and duplicate against the property for collection; and

16
17 WHEREAS, the delinquent Surface Water Management charges shall be levied in the
18 2021 collection year and split equally between 1st and 2nd half collections; and

19
20 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
21 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to certify the aforementioned
22 charges to the Fiscal Officer;

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
25 of Ohio, that:

27 SECTION 1

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29 The delinquent surface water utility accounts listed in Exhibit A, attached hereto and
30 incorporated herein as if fully, restated, are hereby certified to the Fiscal Officer to be placed on
31 the real property tax list and duplicate on their respective parcels for collection in 2021.

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33 SECTION 2

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35 The Clerk of Council shall deliver a copy of this Resolution to the Fiscal Officer who
36 shall record the delinquent surface water utility charges for collection pursuant to the County of
37 Summit Codified Ordinances.

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39 SECTION 3

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41 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
42 welfare of the resident of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
43 ensure the certification of charges to the Fiscal Officer.

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45 SECTION 4

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47 Provided this resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
48 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
49 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.




