WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-275, which authorized the Executive to advertise for bids for the Project, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$200,000.00; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing bids, the Executive has selected Krumroy-Cozad Construction, Inc. as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its September 16, 2020 meeting, awarded a construction contract with Krumroy-Cozad Construction, Inc. for the Project, in an amount not to exceed \$202,820.00, subject to confirmation by this Council;

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned construction contract with Krumroy-Cozad Construction, Inc. is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit:

WHEREAS, this Council further finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$202,820.00 is necessary due to the public health emergency created by the COVID-19 pandemic, and is being done in compliance with the provisions of section 5001 of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Krumroy-Cozad Construction, Inc. for the Summit County Jail Video Arraignment Project at the Summit County Jail, located in the City of Akron, in Council District 4, for an amount not to exceed \$202,820.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said construction contract and any other necessary related documents.

SECTION 2

This Council finds and declares that the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$202,820.00 under the aforementioned program is necessary due to the public health emergency with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic, and is being done in compliance with the provisions of section 5001 of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately authorizes a necessary construction contract for video arraignment services at the Summit County Jail due to the COVID-19 pandemic while continuing to improve their operations to ensure that defendants' and inmates' constitutional rights are protected.
