A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute a grant agreement with Direction Home Akron Canton Area Agency on Aging and Disabilities in an amount not to exceed \$610,000.00, utilizing funding received by the County under Section 5001 of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act") to provide elderly and disabled members of the community with technology to achieve connectivity and declaring such expenditure necessary due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) has had a significant impact on the health and wellbeing of the residents of Summit County and has dramatically impacted many elderly and disabled residents who are more vulnerable to the disease such that they must shelter at home, cutting them off from essential social and medical connections and necessary services; and

Section 1. WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to make a grant to Direction Home Akron Canton Area Agency on Aging and Disabilities ("Direction Home"), in a total amount not to exceed \$610,000.00, from funding received under Section 5001 of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act") to fund the purchase of computers and associated peripherals, meals and wellness kits for qualified Summit County residents and fund those services identified in the Direction Home—CARES Act Funding Proposal for Summit County, attached as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, Direct Home will work with partners in the community such as the Nursing Facility Taskforce, Summit County Nursing Facilities, Probate Court & Volunteer Guardianship Program, Foster Grandparents, ASIA, Inc., Tri-County Independent Living Center and the Summit County Public Library to identify residents in need of such technology; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute a grant agreement with Direction Home in an amount not to exceed \$610,000.00 utilizing CARES Act funds; and

WHEREAS, this Council further finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that authorizing the grant of an amount not to exceed \$610,000.00 to provide technology, meals and wellness kits to qualified Summit County Residents is necessary due to the public health emergency created by the COVID-19 pandemic, and is being done in compliance with the provisions of Section 5001 of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

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SECTION 1

 This Council hereby authorizes the Executive to execute a grant agreement with Direction Home Akron Canton Area Agency on Aging and Disabilities ("Direction Home") in an amount not to exceed \$610,000.00, to be paid from funds received from the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act"), which will be used to provide those services identified in the Direction Home—CARES Act Funding Proposal for Summit County, attached as Exhibit A, to qualified elderly and disabled Summit County residents impacted by the public health emergency created by the COVID-19 pandemic.

SECTION 2

This Council finds and declares that the expenditure of \$610,000.00 under the aforementioned agreement is necessary due to the public health emergency with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic and is being done in compliance with the provisions of Section 5001 of the federal CARES Act.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately authorize the County's financial assistance to Direction Home to assist elderly and disabled residents who have been adversely affected by the COVID-19 pandemic so that the project can be commenced and completed as expeditiously as possible.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
