A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute agreements for the acquisition of drainage easements at 6138 and 6238 Riverview Road, located in the Village of Peninsula, in Council District 1, in a total amount not to exceed \$6,754.00, as part of the Riverview Road Bridge over Slipper Run Emergency Replacement Project, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.		
WHEREAS, during a May 25, 2020 storm, 2.5 inches of rain fell in approximately 40 minutes, causing a water surge in Slipper Run under the Riverview Road Bridge (PNV-009-1180), located in the Village of Peninsula, Council District 1; and		
WHEREAS, a fallen tree in Slipper Run washed into the culvert/stone arch-type bridge over Slipper Run, blocking the regular flow of water; and		
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WHEREAS, the blockage and additional flow of water forced the upstream end of the structure to bend upward and disconnected the culvert pipe from the stone arch portion of the structure, blocking the flow of water in Slipper Run; and

WHEREAS, in addition to structure damage, the resulting 20 feet or more high-water blockage caused the embankment to become saturated and to wash downstream, creating the potential for the roadway to become unstable, thereby creating an unsafe roadway condition; and

WHEREAS, there was a public need to replace the Riverview Road Bridge over Slipper Run and repair the embankment (the "Project") under the emergency procedures stated in the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit Section 177.07(a)(3); and

WHEREAS, certain land must be acquired by the County to be utilized as a drainage easement as part of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the County has negotiated terms for agreements for the acquisition of drainage easements at 6138 and 6238 Riverview Road in the Village of Peninsula, Council District 1 to serve as the necessary public right-of-way for the Project, in a total amount not to exceed \$6,754.00; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute the aforementioned agreements for the acquisition of drainage easements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The Executive is hereby authorized to execute agreements for the acquisition of drainage easements at 6138 and 6238 Riverview Road, in the Village of Peninsula, Council District 1, in a total amount not to exceed \$6,754.00, as part of the Riverview Road over Slipper Run
