7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control, subject to the approval of the**
8 **IT Board, of a purchase contract, at State Term Pricing, with S.A. Comunale Co. for the**
9 **replacement of the access control systems for the Ohio Building and the Medical**
10 **Examiner's Office, in an amount not to exceed \$150,999.58, and declaring such expenditure**
11 **necessary due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019**
12 **(COVID-19), for the Executive's Division of COVID-19 Response, and declaring an**
13 **emergency.**

14 WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic has made it necessary
15 to institute COVID-19 best management practices for access to the County's Offices in the Ohio
16 Building and at the Medical Examiner's Office; and

17
18 WHEREAS, the current access control systems in place at the Ohio Building and the
19 Medical Examiner's Office are old and out dated systems which lack functionality for ease of
20 administration and critical reporting features necessary for tracking and control of individuals
21 entering and leaving the buildings and in areas within each building; and

22
23 WHEREAS, entry doors at the Ohio Building and at the Medical Examiner's Office do
24 not support COVID-19 best management practices; and

25
26 WHEREAS, the hardware and software for the current access control systems at the Ohio
27 Building and the Medical Examiner's Office, which are 15-years old cannot utilize many of the
28 features found in more modern hardware and software and cannot be expanded and because of
29 this limitation, a total replacement is required; and

31 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held November 4, 2020, awarded,
32 subject to the approval of the IT Board, a purchase contract with S.A. Comunale, Inc., at State
33 Term Pricing, for the replacement of hardware, software, programming, installation services to
34 upgrade the access control systems for the Ohio Building and the Medical Examiner's Office, in
35 an amount not to exceed \$150,999.58, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

37 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
38 that the aforementioned purchase contract with S.A. Comunale, Inc. is necessary and in the best
39 interest of the County of Summit; and

41 WHEREAS, this Council further declares that the expenditure of funds totaling
42 \$150,999.58 for the aforementioned contract with S.A. Comunale, Inc. is being done in
43 compliance with the provisions of Section 5001 of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and
44 Economic Security Act ("CARES Act");

46 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

6 The award by the Board of Control, subject to the approval of the IT Board of a purchase
7 contract, at State Term Pricing, with S.A. Comunale Co. for the replacement of hardware,
8 software, programming, installation services to upgrade the access control systems for the Ohio
9 Building and the Medical Examiner's Office, in an amount not to exceed \$150,999.58, is hereby
10 confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said purchase contract and any
11 other necessary related documents.

15 This Council finds and declares that the expenditure of \$150,999.58 for the
16 aforementioned purchase contract with S.A. Comunale, Inc. is necessary due to the public health
17 emergency with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic and is being done in compliance with the
18 provisions of Section 5001 of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act
19 ("CARES Act").

23 This Resolution is declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
24 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately institute
25 COVID-19 best management practices for access to the Ohio Building and the Medical Examiner's
26 Office.

30 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect
31 immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be
32 in force at the earliest time provided by law.

36 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to
37 the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
38 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in

40 Ohio Revised Code.


