7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of professional service**  
8 **contracts with certain providers for Ohio Works First services utilizing State Fiscal Year**  
9 **2021 Temporary Assistance to Needy Families funds, in a total amount not to exceed**  
10 **\$403,498.00, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an**  
11 **emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution 2019-314, which confirmed the  
14 award by the Board of Control of professional service contracts with certain providers for the  
15 State Fiscal Year 2020 Temporary Assistance to Need Families ("TANF") program, from  
16 10/1/19 through 9/30/20, in a total amount not to exceed \$2,197,600.00; and

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18 WHEREAS, the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services ("DFJS") seeks to  
19 enter into new contracts with three providers, Asian Services in Action, Inc., Greenleaf Family  
20 Center and Medina Sheltered Industries, Inc. dba Windfall Industries, for Ohio Works First  
21 services utilizing State Fiscal Year 2021 TANF funds, in a total amount not to exceed  
22 \$403,498.00; and

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24 WHEREAS, the aforementioned providers have a previous history with DJFS that  
25 demonstrates an adherence to contract, fiscal and programmatic requirements; and

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27 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5101:9-4-07(A)(2) of the Ohio Administrative Code,  
28 said services are exempt from competitive bidding requirements due to the provider's subgrantee  
29 status; and

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31 WHEREAS, a list of the services to be performed by said providers is set forth in Exhibit  
32 A, attached to this Resolution; and

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34 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held November 4, 2020, awarded  
35 professional service contracts with said providers for Ohio Works First services utilizing Fiscal  
36 Year 2021 TANF funds, in an amount not to exceed \$403,498.00, subject to confirmation by this  
37 Council; and

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39 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information  
40 that the aforementioned professional service contracts with said providers set forth in Exhibit A  
41 are necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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43 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
44 of Ohio, that:

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48 The award by the Board of Control of professional service contracts with Asian Services  
49 in Action, Inc., Greenleaf Family Center and Medina Sheltered Industries, Inc. dba Windfall  
50 Industries, for Ohio Works First services utilizing State Fiscal Year 2021 Temporary Assistance  
51 for Needy Family funds, in a total amount not to exceed \$403,498.00, as set forth in Exhibit A,  
52 attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein as if fully restated, is hereby confirmed and

7 necessary related documents.

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11 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
12 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
13 enable the providers to provide necessary Ohio Works First services as expeditiously as possible.

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15 SECTION 3


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17 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
