Public Works

A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute five Local Public Agency agreements with the State of Ohio, through the Department of Transportation, located in Council Districts 1, 5, and 8, for resurfacing projects on White Pond Drive and Cleveland-Massillon Road, the replacement of the Pressler Road Bridge over South Fork of the Tuscarawas River, the replacement of the Christman Road Bridge over the Nimisila Reservoir, and an intersection improvement at Olde 8 Road and Twinsburg Road, for an estimated total projects' cost not to exceed \$5,042,000.00, with the Department of Transportation providing federal grant funds of up to \$3,412,600.00, to cover up to 80% of the projects' costs, with the Engineer being responsible for the balance of the projects' costs, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Engineer's Office has received grant awards for the resurfacing of White Pond Drive from State Route 162 to the City of Akron line (Project Identification Number 108200), the resurfacing of Cleveland-Massillon Road from 400 feet north of Minor Road to Ridgewood Road (Project Identification Number 108468), the replacement of the Pressler Road Bridge over the South Fork of the Tuscarawas River (Project Identification Number 113152), the replacement of the Christman Road Bridge over the Nimisila Reservoir (Project Identification 113945) and the installation of a traffic signal at Olde 8 Road and Twinsburg Road (Project Identification Number 114044), (herein after referred to as the "Projects"); and

WHEREAS, the estimated total cost of the Projects is \$5,042,000.00; and

WHEREAS, various federal grant funds have been awarded, in an amount not to exceed \$3,412,600.00, to cover up to 80% of the Projects' costs, with the Engineer's Office being responsible to provide the remaining funds necessary for the Projects' costs; and

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT"), and the Engineer desire to enter into Local Public Agency ("LPA") agreements, to confirm the Projects' costs and to designate the County of Summit as the lead agency for administration of the Projects; and

WHEREAS, Sections 5501.03(c) and 5543.01 of the Ohio Revised Code, as well as Article II, Section 2.03(5) of the County of Summit Charter allow execution of such LPA agreements, subject to the approval of this Council; and

WHEREAS, said LPA Agreements will provide (i) that the estimated cost of the Projects (ii) that ODOT shall provide to the County as the LPA up to 80% of eligible Project costs, in Surface Transportation Block Grant funds, Federal Ohio Bridge Partnership funds, and up to 100% of Federal Safety funds, and (iii) that the County, as the LPA, will provide the remaining funds necessary to pay for the Projects' costs, with the City of Green providing 50% of the local costs for the Christman Road Bridge project and Toll Revenue funds covering the local cost of the Pressler Road Bridge Project; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, by reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute the aforementioned LPA agreements with ODOT; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The Executive is hereby authorized to execute Local Public Agency ("LPA") agreements with the State of Ohio, through the Department of Transportation ("ODOT"), for the White Pond Drive Resurfacing Project (Project Identification Number 108200), the Cleveland-Massillon Road Resurfacing Project (Project Identification Number 108468), the Pressler Road Bridge over the South Fork of the Tuscarawas River Replacement Project (Project Identification Number 113152), the Christman Road Bridge over the Nimisila Reservoir Replacement Project (Project Identification 113945) and the Olde 8 Road and Twinsburg Road Intersection Improvement Project (Project Identification Number 114044 (the "Projects") located in Council Districts 1, 5, and 8, with a copy of each LPA agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated fully herein, with such modifications and revisions as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of said LPA agreements and not substantially adverse to the County, all of which shall be conclusively evidenced by the execution thereof by the executive Upon federal authorization from ODOT, the County may commence the administration of the Project, with the award of the Project subject to applicable Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, said Ordinances requiring authorization of such an award by the Board of Control and/or County Council.

SECTION 2

The LPA agreements will show the Projects' descriptions and costs are broken down as follows:

- 1. White Pond Drive Resurfacing Project, located in Copley Township, Project Identification Number 108200, total cost of \$880,000.00, with Surface Transportation Block Grant funding covering up to 80% of construction costs, up to \$600,000.00.
- 2. Cleveland-Massillon Road Resurfacing Project, located in Copley Township, Project Identification Number 108468, total cost of \$1,170,000.00 with Surface Transportation Block Grant funding covering up to 80% of construction costs, up to \$700,000.00.
- 3. Pressler Road Bridge Replacement, located in Springfield Township, Project Identification number 113152, total cost of \$1,250.000.00, with Ohio Bridge Partnership funding covering up to 80% of construction costs and Toll Revenue Credit funding covering the local share of 20%.
- 4. Christman Road Bridge Replacement, located in the City of Green, Project Identification Number 113945, total cost of \$1,550,000.00 with Local Bridge Program funding covering 80% of the construction costs, and the City of Green and Summit County Engineer's office each paying 50% of the local share.
- 5. Olde 8 and Twinsburg Road Intersection Improvement Project, located in Northfield Center Township, Project Identification Number 114044, total cost of \$192,500.00 with Federal Safety funds covering up 100% of the construction costs, not to exceed \$175,000.00.
