7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute five Local Public Agency agreements**
8 **with the State of Ohio, through the Department of Transportation, located in Council**
9 **Districts 1, 5, and 8, for resurfacing projects on White Pond Drive and Cleveland-Massillon**
10 **Road, the replacement of the Pressler Road Bridge over South Fork of the Tuscarawas**
11 **River, the replacement of the Christman Road Bridge over the Nimisila Reservoir, and an**
12 **intersection improvement at Olde 8 Road and Twinsburg Road, for an estimated total**
13 **projects' cost not to exceed \$5,042,000.00, with the Department of Transportation**
14 **providing federal grant funds of up to \$3,412,600.00, to cover up to 80% of the projects'**
15 **costs, with the Engineer being responsible for the balance of the projects' costs, for the**
16 **Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

18 WHEREAS, the Engineer's Office has received grant awards for the resurfacing of White
19 Pond Drive from State Route 162 to the City of Akron line (Project Identification Number
20 108200), the resurfacing of Cleveland-Massillon Road from 400 feet north of Minor Road to
21 Ridgewood Road (Project Identification Number 108468), the replacement of the Pressler Road
22 Bridge over the South Fork of the Tuscarawas River (Project Identification Number 113152), the
23 replacement of the Christman Road Bridge over the Nimisila Reservoir (Project Identification
24 113945) and the installation of a traffic signal at Olde 8 Road and Twinsburg Road (Project
25 Identification Number 114044), (herein after referred to as the "Projects"); and

27 WHEREAS, the estimated total cost of the Projects is \$5,042,000.00; and

28
29 WHEREAS, various federal grant funds have been awarded, in an amount not to exceed
30 \$3,412,600.00, to cover up to 80% of the Projects' costs, with the Engineer's Office being
31 responsible to provide the remaining funds necessary for the Projects' costs; and

33 WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Transportation
34 ("ODOT"), and the Engineer desire to enter into Local Public Agency ("LPA") agreements, to
35 confirm the Projects' costs and to designate the County of Summit as the lead agency for
36 administration of the Projects; and

38 WHEREAS, Sections 5501.03(c) and 5543.01 of the Ohio Revised Code, as well as
39 Article II, Section 2.03(5) of the County of Summit Charter allow execution of such LPA
40 agreements, subject to the approval of this Council; and

42 WHEREAS, said LPA Agreements will provide (i) that the estimated cost of the Projects
43 (ii) that ODOT shall provide to the County as the LPA up to 80% of eligible Project costs, in
44 Surface Transportation Block Grant funds, Federal Ohio Bridge Partnership funds, and up to
45 100% of Federal Safety funds, and (iii) that the County, as the LPA, will provide the remaining
46 funds necessary to pay for the Projects' costs, with the City of Green providing 50% of the local
47 costs for the Christman Road Bridge project and Toll Revenue funds covering the local cost of
48 the Pressler Road Bridge Project; and

50 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, by reviewing all pertinent information,
51 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
52 execute the aforementioned LPA agreements with ODOT; and

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
5 of Ohio, that:

7 SECTION 1

8
9 The Executive is hereby authorized to execute Local Public Agency (“LPA”) agreements
10 with the State of Ohio, through the Department of Transportation (“ODOT”), for the White Pond
11 Drive Resurfacing Project (Project Identification Number 108200), the Cleveland-Massillon
12 Road Resurfacing Project (Project Identification Number 108468), the Pressler Road Bridge over
13 the South Fork of the Tuscarawas River Replacement Project (Project Identification Number
14 113152), the Christman Road Bridge over the Nimisila Reservoir Replacement Project (Project
15 Identification 113945) and the Olde 8 Road and Twinsburg Road Intersection Improvement
16 Project (Project Identification Number 114044 (the “Projects”) located in Council Districts 1, 5,
17 and 8, with a copy of each LPA agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated fully
18 herein, with such modifications and revisions as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of said
19 LPA agreements and not substantially adverse to the County, all of which shall be conclusively
20 evidenced by the execution thereof by the Executive. Upon federal
21 authorization from ODOT, the County may commence the administration of the Project, with the
22 award of the Project subject to applicable Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, said
23 Ordinances requiring authorization of such an award by the Board of Control and/or County
24 Council.

28 The LPA agreements will show the Projects’ descriptions and costs are broken down as
29 follows:

31 1. White Pond Drive Resurfacing Project, located in Copley Township, Project
32 Identification Number 108200, total cost of \$880,000.00, with Surface Transportation
33 Block Grant funding covering up to 80% of construction costs, up to \$600,000.00.
34 2. Cleveland-Massillon Road Resurfacing Project, located in Copley Township, Project
35 Identification Number 108468, total cost of \$1,170,000.00 with Surface Transportation
36 Block Grant funding covering up to 80% of construction costs, up to \$700,000.00.
37 3. Pressler Road Bridge Replacement, located in Springfield Township, Project
38 Identification number 113152, total cost of \$1,250,000.00, with Ohio Bridge Partnership
39 funding covering up to 80% of construction costs and Toll Revenue Credit funding
40 covering the local share of 20%.
41 4. Christman Road Bridge Replacement, located in the City of Green, Project Identification
42 Number 113945, total cost of \$1,550,000.00 with Local Bridge Program funding
43 covering 80% of the construction costs, and the City of Green and Summit County
44 Engineer’s office each paying 50% of the local share.
45 5. Olde 8 and Twinsburg Road Intersection Improvement Project, located in Northfield
46 Center Township, Project Identification Number 114044, total cost of \$192,500.00 with
47 Federal Safety funds covering up 100% of the construction costs, not to exceed
48 \$175,000.00.
