7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive, subject to approval by the Board of**  
8 **Control, to execute a purchase agreement with Technical Communities, Inc., for additional**  
9 **licenses for the County's QMatic Orchestra System, in an amount not to exceed**  
10 **\$115,000.00, for the Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2015-549, this Council authorized the purchase  
13 by the Department of Job and Family Services of a QMatic Orchestra System in the amount of  
14 \$72,865.21; and

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16 WHEREAS, the Department of Job and Family Services requires additional licenses for  
17 the QMatic Orchestra System that will be utilized at their new building; and

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19 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is  
20 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute  
21 the aforementioned purchase and Lease-Purchase Agreements;

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23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
24 of Ohio, that:

28 The County Executive is hereby authorized, subject to approval by the Board of Control,  
29 to execute a purchase agreement with Technical Communities, Inc., for additional licenses for  
30 the County's QMatic Orchestra System, in an amount not to exceed \$115,000.00, for the  
31 Department of Job and Family Services.

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33 SECTION 2

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35 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
36 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of timely authorizing  
37 the purchase agreement and Lease-Purchase agreement in order to complete this project in time  
38 for the Department of Job and Family Service's move to their new building.

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40 SECTION 3

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42 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
44 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
