7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of an IV-D intergovernmental**
8 **agreement with the County Court of Common Pleas- Domestic Relations Division for**
9 **magistrate services provided relative to child support cases, for a one-year term, from**
10 **1/1/16 to 12/31/16, in an amount not to exceed \$793,451.12 for the Prosecutor- Child**
11 **Support Enforcement Agency, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting on February 3, 2016, awarded an IV-D
14 intergovernmental agreement with the County Court of Common Pleas- Domestic Relations for
15 magistrate services provided relative to child support cases for the County Prosecutor's Child
16 Support Enforcement Agency, for a one-year term, from 1/1/2016 to 12/31/16, in an amount not
17 to exceed \$793,451.12; and

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19 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information,
20 that the aforementioned IV-D intergovernmental agreement with the Court of Common Pleas-
21 Domestic Relations is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
24 of Ohio, that;

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26 SECTION 1

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28 The award by the Board of Control of an IV-D intergovernmental agreement with the
29 County Court of Common Pleas- Domestic Relations Division for magistrate services provided
30 relative to child support cases, for a one-year term, from 1/1/16 to 12/31/16, in an amount not to
31 exceed \$793,451.12 is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to
32 execute such intergovernmental agreement.

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34 SECTION 2

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36 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
37 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately
38 providing necessary magistrate services for child support cases for the Prosecutor's Child
39 Support Enforcement Agency effective 1/1/16.

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43 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
44 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
45 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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
