7 **A Resolution adjusting existing appropriations in the amount of \$17,565.40 within the**
8 **Federal Fiscal Year 2015 Victims of Crime Act grant, ending 9/30/16, for the Prosecutor,**
9 **and declaring an emergency.**

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11 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2015-493, which authorized
12 the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award from the State of
13 Ohio Attorney General's Office of a Federal Fiscal Year 2015 Victims of Crime Act grant, in the
14 amount of \$269,402.86, with a local cash match requirement of \$67,350.73, for a total grant of
15 \$336,753.59, and appropriating said grant funds; and

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17 WHEREAS, it is necessary to adjust existing appropriations in order to meet the needs of
18 the County Prosecutor's office;

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20 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information,
21 that the adjustment of existing appropriations by \$17,565.40 within the 2015 Federal Fiscal Year
22 Victim of Crime Act grant, ending 9/30/16, is necessary and in the best interest of the County of
23 Summit;
