7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute an intergovernmental agreement**
8 **between the Office of Information Technology and the Summit-Akron Solid Waste**
9 **Management Authority for the Office of Information Technology to provide information**
10 **systems technology and data processing support to the Summit-Akron Solid Waste**
11 **Management Authority, for a three-year term, with two options to renew for an additional**
12 **three-year term, for the Office of Information Technology, and declaring an emergency.**

14 WHEREAS, the Summit-Akron Solid Waste Management Authority (“Reworks”) wishes
15 to have the Office of Information Technology (“Office”) provide information systems
16 technology and data processing support services to Reworks, for a three-year term, with two
17 options to renew for an additional three-year term; and

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19 WHEREAS, the Information Technology Board, at its April 28th meeting, adopted
20 Directive No. IT 2016-09, which authorizes the County Executive to execute the aforementioned
21 intergovernmental agreement between the Office of Information Technology and Reworks; and

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23 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
24 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the County Executive to
25 execute the aforementioned intergovernmental agreement between the Office of Information
26 Technology and Reworks;

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28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
29 State of Ohio, that:

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31 SECTION 1

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33 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement
34 with the Office of Information Technology and the Summit-Akron Solid Waste Management
35 Authority, for the Office to provide information systems technology and data processing support
36 to the Authority. The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute said intergovernmental
37 agreement in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit A. The intergovernmental
38 agreement is approved with changes therein not inconsistent with this Resolution and not
39 substantially adverse to the County which shall be approved by the County Executive; provided
40 that the approval of those changes by the County Executive and the character of such changes as
41 not being substantially adverse to the County shall be evidenced conclusively by the execution of
42 the intergovernmental agreement.

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44 SECTION 2

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46 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
47 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately
48 authorizing the Executive to execute a necessary intergovernmental agreement for the Office of
49 Information Technology to provide information systems technology and data processing support
50 to the Akron-Summit Solid Waste Management Authority.

7 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
8 effect and be in force at the earliest possible time provided by law.
