8 **A Resolution authorizing the County Engineer to establish the intersection of Riverview**
9 **Road and Boston Mills Road in Boston Township as a four-way stop intersection for the**
10 **period 5/14/16 through 5/31/16, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, Section 5553.02 of the Ohio Revised Code grants authority to locate, alter,
13 or vacate roads to the Board of County Commissioners; and

14
15 WHEREAS, Section 5553.04 of the Ohio Revised Code establishes the procedure for
16 establishing, altering or vacating roads; and

17
18 WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad desires to celebrate the “Day Out
19 With Thomas” event, and has asked the County Engineer to assist in traffic control by
20 establishing a four-way stop at the intersection at Riverview Road and Boston Mills Road, in
21 Council District 1, due to the increased vehicular and pedestrian traffic anticipated during the
22 time of this event;

24 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
25 that authorizing the Engineer to establish the aforementioned temporary four-way stop
26 intersection is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
29 of Ohio, that:

31 SECTION 1

32
33 The County Engineer is hereby authorized to establish the intersection of Riverview Road
34 and Boston Mills Road as a temporary four-way stop intersection for the period 5/14/16 through
35 5/31/16, after which said intersection shall revert to a two-way stop intersection with the stop
36 signs installed for the eastbound and westbound Boston Mills Road traffic.

38 SECTION 2

40 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
41 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it ensures safe
42 travel for pedestrians and workers for the “Day Out With Thomas” event.

44 SECTION 3

46 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
47 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
48 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


