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7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute an intergovernmental**
8 **cooperative/mutual aid agreement with the City of Cleveland for the County Sheriff's**
9 **Office to provide assistance of law enforcement personnel and/or equipment for public**
10 **safety-related aid and assistance during the 2016 Republican National Convention, to be**
11 **held in Cleveland during the week of July 18, 2016, for the Sheriff, and declaring an**
12 **emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the City of Cleveland, Ohio, has been selected to host the 2016 Republican
15 National Convention ("RNC") during the week of July 18, 2016; and

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17 WHEREAS, the RNC has been designated a National Special Security Event ("NSSE")
18 due to the event's significance to the United States and the inherent challenge of ensuring the
19 safety and security of all event participants; and

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21 WHEREAS, pursuant to this NSSE classification, the United States Secret Service is the
22 authorized lead for the design and implementation of the official operational security plan
23 pertaining to the RNC; and

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25 WHEREAS, the City of Cleveland through its Division of Police in the Department of
26 Public Safety is responsible for coordinating local law enforcement efforts for the RNC; and

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28 WHEREAS, the RNC is expected to attract in excess of 50,000 visitors that will include
29 persons who will engage in their constitutional rights of free speech; and

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31 WHEREAS, the City of Cleveland has applied or will apply to the United States
32 Department of Justice for a federal grant to help defray the expense of providing a secure venue
33 for the RNC delegates and for ensuring the opportunity for the lawful exercise of constitutional
34 rights by all persons; and

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36 WHEREAS, law enforcement officers from all levels of government throughout the State
37 of Ohio and in other states will be needed to provide law enforcement services for the event; and

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39 WHEREAS, law enforcement agencies providing personnel for the RNC are considered
40 to be subrecipients of the federal grant and eligible for reimbursement for personnel and other
41 costs subject to the terms of both this Agreement and the grant; and

43 WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code §737.04 provides authority for a municipal corporation
44 to enter into agreements to obtain additional police protection from a municipal corporation,
45 township, township police districts, joint police districts, county sheriffs, park districts, or port
46 authorities; and

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48 WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code §9.482 provides authority for a political subdivision,
49 upon authorization of its legislature, to enter into an agreement with another political subdivision
50 to render services for the political subdivision that the other political subdivision is otherwise
51 legally authorized to perform or render; and

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4 WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code §5502.41 provides for the Ohio Mutual Aid Compact to
5 complement existing mutual aid agreements to allow a political subdivision to request assistance
6 with planned events such as the RNC and receive assistance from any other political subdivision
7 in the state; and

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9 WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code §5502.29 permits an Ohio political subdivision to enter
10 into mutual aid agreements with political subdivisions in Ohio and in neighboring states for
11 assistance with a planned event; and

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13 WHEREAS, at the request of the City of Cleveland, the County of Summit is willing to
14 provide, through the County Sheriff's Office, the assistance of law enforcement personnel and/or
15 equipment for public safety-related aid and assistance during the RNC; and

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17 WHEREAS, the City of Cleveland and the County of Summit wish to enter into an
18 intergovernmental cooperative/mutual aid agreement to outline the terms and conditions for the
19 County Sheriff's Office to provide the assistance of law enforcement personnel and/or equipment
20 for public safety-related aid and assistance during the RNC; and

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22 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
23 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the County Executive to
24 execute the aforementioned intergovernmental cooperative/mutual aid agreement the City of
25 Cleveland and the County for the County Sheriff's Office to provide the aforementioned
26 assistance during the RNC;

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28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
29 State of Ohio, that:

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31 SECTION 1

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33 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental
34 cooperative/mutual aid agreement the City of Cleveland for the County Sheriff's Office to
35 provide assistance of law enforcement personnel and/or equipment for public safety-related aid
36 and assistance during the 2016 Republican National Convention ("RNC") to be held in
37 Cleveland during the week of July 18, 2016. The County Executive is hereby authorized to
38 execute said intergovernmental cooperative/mutual aid agreement in substantially the form
39 attached hereto as Exhibit A. The intergovernmental cooperative/mutual aid agreement is hereby
40 approved with any changes approved by the County Executive that are not inconsistent with this
41 Resolution and not substantially adverse to the County. The approval of those changes by the
42 County Executive and the character of such changes as not being substantially adverse to the
43 County shall be evidenced conclusively by the execution of the intergovernmental
44 cooperative/mutual aid agreement.

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4 SECTION 2

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6 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
7 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately
8 authorizing the Executive to execute a necessary intergovernmental cooperative/mutual aid
9 agreement with the City of Cleveland for County Sheriff's Office to provide assistance during
10 the RNC.

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12 SECTION 3

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14 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
15 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
16 effect and be in force at the earliest possible time provided by law.

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18 SECTION 4

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20 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
21 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
22 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
23 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
24 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

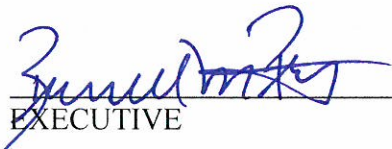
