7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**  
8 **accept an Ohio Courts Technology Initiative grant from the Supreme Court of Ohio, for**  
9 **the period 5/4/16 through 9/1/16, in the amount of \$30,980.00, with no local match**  
10 **requirement, and appropriating said grant funds, for the Court of Common Pleas- General**  
11 **Division, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Supreme Court of Ohio has awarded the Summit County Court of  
14 Common Pleas- General Division an Ohio Courts Technology Initiative grant, for the period  
15 5/4/16 through 9/1/16, in an amount of \$30,980.00, with no local match requirement; and

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17 WHEREAS, the aforementioned Ohio Courts Technology Initiative grant will be used to  
18 aid in the completions of the Court of Common Pleas- General Division's network infrastructure  
19 project; and

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21 WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate said grant funds; and

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23 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
24 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County  
25 Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned Ohio  
26 Courts Technology Initiative grant and to appropriate said grant funds;

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33 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept  
34 the award of an Ohio Courts Technology Initiative grant from the Supreme Court of Ohio, for  
35 the period 5/4/16 through 9/1/16, in the amount of \$30,980.00, with no local match required, for  
36 the Court of Common Pleas- General Division.

SECTION 5




