5 6 7 8	WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 5709.40 and 5709.83 of the Ohio Revised Code, the City of Hudson intends to create an incentive district within the City of Hudson, in County Council District 3, and depicted on Exhibit A and consisting of the permanent parcel numbers shown on Exhibit A, exempting from real property taxation certain improvements constructed within the district; and		
) l	WHEREAS, the improvements proposed to be constructed within the district include residential developments; and		
2	WHEREAS, to finance the costs of the improvements, the City of Hudson desires to exempt 100% of the private improvements in the district from real property taxation for a period of 20 years;		
4 5 6 7 8 9 0	WHEREAS, Section 5709.40(E) of the Ohio Revised Code, provides that a board of county commissioners must receive notice of a proposed incentive district exemption for a number of years in excess of ten or for a percentage of exemption in excess of seventy-five percent at least forty-five business days prior to the adoption of such an ordinance by the municipality, and further provides that a board of county commissioners, by resolution, may object to the exemption for a number of years in excess of ten, may object to the exemption for the percentage of the improvement to be exempted in excess of seventy-five percent, or both, and the board shall certify its resolution to the legislative authority not later than thirty days after the receipt of the notice of intent; and		
2 3 4	WHEREAS, this Council supports the creation of said incentive district within the City of Hudson which would exempt from real property taxation improvements constructed within the district for the term and in the percentage amount set forth above; and

SECTION 1

The County of Summit hereby supports the creation of an incentive district within the City of Hudson, in County Council District 3, which would exempt from real property taxation certain improvements constructed within the district.

SECTION 2

The County of Summit hereby waives its right to receipt of the notice of intent, pursuant to Section 5709.40(E) of the Ohio Revised Code, at least forty-five days prior to the City of Hudson adopting an ordinance creating the above-referenced incentive district exemption for a number of years in excess of ten or for a percentage of exemption in excess of seventy-five percent.

SECTION 3

The County of Summit hereby waives its right to object, pursuant to Section 5709.40(E) of the Ohio Revised Code, to the proposed exemption for a number of years in excess of ten or for the percentage of the improvements to be exempted in excess of seventy-five percent.

SECTION 4

The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to send a certified copy of this Resolution to Jane Howington, City Manager for the City of Hudson.

SECTION 5

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately support the creation of an incentive district within the City of Hudson and to expedite the project.

SECTION 6

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 7

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
