NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The Summit County Council hereby declares Wednesday, June 15, 2016 as Elder Abuse Awareness Day and encourages all the residents of the County to participate in any events and programs offered by the communities, libraries, schools, governments and private-sector institutions of the County in observance of this day.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately declaring support of Elder Abuse Awareness Day in Summit County prior to the commencement of said day.

SECTION 3

The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to distribute this Resolution to all political subdivisions within the County of Summit.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest possible time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
