7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with AE**  
8 **Security Group, as a Best Practical Source, for the upgrade of the door locking and card**  
9 **access system at the juvenile detention facility, in an amount not to exceed \$174,900.00, for**  
10 **the Court of Common Pleas – Juvenile Division, and declaring an emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held June 15, 2016, awarded a purchase  
13 contract to AE Security Group, as a Best Practical Source, for the upgrade of the door locking  
14 and card access system at the detention facility, in an amount not to exceed \$174,900.00, subject  
15 to confirmation by County Council; and

17 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information,  
18 that the aforementioned purchase contract with AE Security Group is necessary and in the best  
19 interest of the County of Summit;

21 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
22 of Ohio, that:

24 SECTION 1

26 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with AE Security Group, for  
27 the upgrade of the door locking and card access system at the juvenile detention facility, in an  
28 amount not to exceed \$174,900.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby  
29 authorized to execute such purchase contract.

31 SECTION 2

33 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
34 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
35 provide for the upgrade of the door locking and card access system at the juvenile detention  
36 facility.

40 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
41 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
42 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

46 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
47 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
48 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
49 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
50 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


