A 2020 year-end Resolution ratifying actions taken by the Executive and other Charter Officeholders during 2020 to address the impact of COVID-19 on County operations and employment, authorizing the Executive to amend CARES Act grant award funding sources, as necessary, in order to provide the flexibility to fully utilize all CARES Act funds previously approved, and appropriating funds totaling \$933,083.58 and adjusting appropriations totaling \$9,690,571.32 in order to meet projected expenditures for the balance of 2020 as set forth in Exhibit A, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, 2020 has operationally been a challenging year due to the impact of COVID-19, requiring County appointing authorities, to implement measures designed to keep County services functioning while keeping their employees safe, including but not limited to, the creation of a temporary Division of COVID-19 Response, the creation and implementation of remote work policies, the temporary placement of certain employees on paid administrative leave, the temporary loaning of employees to the Division COVID-19 Response, the creation of an amended ordinance to allow for County employees to be assigned to work as precinct election officials, the creation of CARES Act programs to address jobs, housing and utility assistance along with the assignment of County employees to help manage those programs, the creation and staffing of a PPE stockpile and the implementation of numerous technology and capital projects; and

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolutions 2020-076 and 2020-140 authorizing the Executive to temporarily modify, as necessary, sections of Chapter 169 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit entitled "Personnel Policies and Procedures," by Executive Order, until December 30, 2020, in order that appointing authorities of the County of Summit shall have the necessary flexibility to address the operational impact of the Public Health Emergency created by the COVID-19 Coronavirus; and

WHEREAS, the Executive enacted Executive Orders 2020-054 entitled Modification of section 169.22(e) of the Codified Ordinances, 2020-055 entitled Implementation of Essential/Non-Essential personnel categories and rules of the County of Summit, 2020-088 entitled Paid Parental Leave, 2020-095 entitled Modification of section 169.15 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit and 2020-117 entitled Modification of Section 169.22(c) copies of which are attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolutions 2020-342 authorizing the County Executive to amend CARES Act grant awards, as necessary, in order provide the flexibility to fully utilize all CARES Act funds previously approved, prior to expiration of the CARES Act on December 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, in addition to amending CARES Act grant award amounts between grant recipients, it is also necessary to modify, in certain cases, the funding source from which the awards have been paid, subject to appropriation; and

WHEREAS, certain operations of the County of Summit require appropriations in the amount of \$933,083.58 and adjusting appropriations totaling \$9,690,571.32 in order to meet obligations for the balance of the 2020 calendar year as set forth in Exhibit B, attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein as if fully restated; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that ratifying actions taken by the Executive and other Charter Officeholders including this Council, in 2020, to address the operational challenges presented by COVID-19, in compliance with of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit and/or Executive Orders issued by the Executive, and/or Policies and Procedures of said Charter Officeholders, authorizing the Executive to modify, in certain cases, the funding source from which CARES Act grant awards have been paid, subject to appropriation and the appropriations contained in Exhibit B are immediately needed for operations of the County and are necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## **SECTION 1**

 Actions taken by the Executive and other Charter Officeholders, including this Council, in 2020, to address the operational challenges presented by COVID-19, in compliance with the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit and/or Executive Orders issued by the Executive, and/or Policies and Procedures of said Charter Officeholders, are hereby ratified.

# **SECTION 2**

The Executive is hereby authorized to modify, in certain cases, the funding source from which CARES Act grant awards have been paid, subject to appropriation by this Council.

## **SECTION 3**

The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to effect the appropriations set forth in Exhibit B, attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein as if fully restated.

## **SECTION 4**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason that the appropriations contained in Exhibit B are immediately needed for operations of the County.

#### **SECTION 5**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
