SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with The Apostolos Group, Inc. dba Thomarios for construction manager services for the Combined 911 Dispatch Center (the "Project"), located in the City of Tallmadge, in Council District 6, in an amount not to exceed \$564,360.00 is hereby confirmed, and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said professional service contract and any other necessary related documents.

SECTION 2

This Council hereby makes the following declaration of official intent under United States Treasury Regulations for purposes of Sections 103 and 141 to 150 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (the "Internal Revenue Code"). This Council declares, on behalf of the County, that it reasonably expects the expenditures related to the construction manager services, along with the costs for acquiring, constructing, equipping and any other expenses related to the Combined 911 Dispatch Center will be reimbursed with the proceeds of the bonds (as defined in Section 150 of the Internal Revenue Code). The maximum principal amount of bonds expected to be issued for the purpose described in this Section 2 is not to exceed \$15,000,000.00.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide for necessary construction manager services for the Project.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5
