7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a**  
8 **professional service contract with the United Way of Summit and Medina fka United Way**  
9 **of Summit County to provide 2-1-1 information and referral services to assist low income**  
10 **families in accessing non-profit and government services to meet basic needs, for the period**  
11 **10/1/20 through 9/30/21, in an amount not to exceed \$200,000.00 (for a cumulative increase**  
12 **of 200%) for a total amount not to exceed \$300,000.00, for the Executive's Department of**  
13 **Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

14  
15 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-187, which confirmed  
16 the award by the Board of Control of professional service contracts with certain providers for  
17 State Fiscal Year 2021 of Title XX funded services and Temporary Assistance to Needy Families  
18 ("TANF") funded services, from 7/1/20 through 6/30/21, and from 10/1/20 through 9/30/21, in a  
19 total amount not to exceed \$500,000.00; which included an award to with the United Way of  
20 Summit and Medina fka United Way of Summit County (the "United Way"), as a Best Practical  
21 Source, to provide 2-1-1 information and referral services to assist low income families in  
22 accessing non-profit and government services to meet basic needs, for the period 10/1/20 through  
23 9/30/21, in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00; and

25 WHEREAS, pursuant to the professional service contract, the United Way provides 2-1-1  
26 information and referral services to assist low income families in accessing nonprofit and  
27 government services to meet basic needs (such as food, affordable housing, utility assistance,  
28 clothing and low cost health care services), as well as preventative services and resources to  
29 attain self-sufficiency; and

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31 WHEREAS, 2-1-1 services are offered 24 hours a day, seven days a week and provide  
32 information on over 10,300 different services for Summit County residents; and

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34 WHEREAS, because of the COVID-19 pandemic there is increased need for the services  
35 provided under this agreement, it is necessary to increase the amount of the contract; and

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37 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held March 10, 2021, awarded Change  
38 Order No. 1 to the professional service contract with the United Way, in an amount not to exceed  
39 \$200,000.00 (for a cumulative increase of 200%) for a total amount not to exceed \$300,000.00,  
40 subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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42 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information  
43 that Change Order No. 1 to the aforementioned professional service contract with United Way is  
44 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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46 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

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51 The award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a professional service  
52 contract with the United Way of Summit and Medina fka United Way of Summit County, as

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6 a Best Practical Source, to provide 2-1-1 information and referral services to assist low income  
7 families in accessing non-profit and government services to meet basic needs, for the period  
8 10/1/20 through 9/30/21, in an amount not to exceed \$200,000.00 (for a cumulative increase of  
9 200%) for a total amount not to exceed \$300,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is  
10 hereby authorized to execute said professional service contract and any other necessary related  
11 documents.

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13 SECTION 2

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15 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
16 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
17 provide additional 2-1-1 information and referral services to assist low income families.

19 SECTION 3

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21 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
22 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
23 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

25 SECTION 4

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27 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
28 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
29 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
30 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
31 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


