7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with**
8 **Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc. for the 2021 Summit County 441 Asphalt Concrete (448)**
9 **Resurfacing Program-North, in an amount not to exceed \$1,987,606.70, for the Engineer,**
10 **and declaring an emergency.**

11
12 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-416, which authorized
13 the Executive to advertise, as needed, for bridge engineering and construction projects, and
14 pavement maintenance projects, for the Engineer's 2021 Capital Improvements Program, and
15 federal and state funded projects, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$9,117,500.00; and

16
17 WHEREAS, said projects were approved as part of the Capital Improvements Program
18 for 2021-2026 by Resolution No. 2021-037; and

19
20 WHEREAS, following the receipt and review of bids, the Executive has proposed
21 entering into a construction contract with Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc. for the 2021 Summit
22 County 441 Asphalt Concrete (448) Resurfacing Program-North, in an amount not to exceed
23 \$1,987,606.70; and

25 WHEREAS, the work to be performed by Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc. will consist of
26 resurfacing various County, Bath Township, Richfield Township, Sagamore Hills Township and
27 Twinsburg Township roads, including milling, pavement repairs, chip seal prior to resurfacing,
28 an asphalt concrete surface course and new pavement markings; and

30 WHEREAS, the contract total will be broken down by political subdivision as follows
31 with each subdivision responsible for directly paying the contractor:

33 County (Including Revere Road alternate): \$1,077,187.60
34 Bath Township: \$373,633.30
35 Richfield Township: \$48,900.00
36 Sagamore Hills Township: \$338,758.20
37 Twinsburg Township: \$149,127.60

39 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on April 7, 2021, awarded a
40 construction contract with Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc., as the lowest responsive and responsible
41 bidder, for the 2021 Summit County 441 Asphalt Concrete (448) Resurfacing Program-North, in
42 an amount not to exceed \$1,987,606.70, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

44 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
45 that the aforementioned construction contract with Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc. for the 2021
46 Summit County 441 Asphalt Concrete (448) Resurfacing Program-North is necessary and in the
47 best interest of the County of Summit;

6 The award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Chagrin Valley
7 Paving, Inc. for the 2021 Summit County 441 Asphalt Concrete (448) Resurfacing Program-
8 North, in an amount not to exceed \$1,987,606.70, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is
9 hereby authorized to execute said construction contract and any other necessary related
10 documents.

12 SECTION 2

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14 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
15 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately
16 provide necessary pavement repairs to various County, Bath Township, Sagamore Hills
17 Township, Richfield Township, and Twinsburg Township roads.

19 SECTION 3




