7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with**
8 **Barbicas Construction Co. for the 2021 Summit County 441 Asphalt Concrete (448)**
9 **Resurfacing Program-South, in an amount not to exceed \$1,713,336.91, for the Engineer,**
10 **and declaring an emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-416, which authorized
13 the Executive to advertise, as needed, for bridge engineering and construction projects, and
14 pavement maintenance projects, for the Engineer's 2021 Capital Improvements Program, and
15 federal and state funded projects, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$9,117,500.00; and
16

17 WHEREAS, said projects were approved as part of the Capital Improvements Program
18 for 2021-2026 by Resolution No. 2021-037; and
19

20 WHEREAS, following the receipt and review of bids, the Executive has proposed
21 entering into a construction contract with Barbicas Construction Co. for the 2021 Summit
22 County 441 Asphalt Concrete (448) Resurfacing Program-South in an amount not to exceed
23 \$1,713,336.91; and

25 WHEREAS, the work to be performed by Barbicas Construction Co. will consist of
26 resurfacing various County, County Alternate, Copley Township, and Springfield Township
27 roads, including milling, pavement repairs, chip seal prior to resurfacing, an asphalt concrete
28 surface course and new pavement markings; and

30 WHEREAS, the contract total in an amount not to exceed \$1,713,336.91 will be broken
31 down by political subdivision as follows with each subdivision responsible for directly paying
32 the contractor:

34 County share: \$1,237,067.60

35 County Alternate: \$29,344.00

36 Copley Township: \$376,986.90

37 Springfield Township: \$69,938.41

39 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on April 7, 2021, awarded a
40 construction contract with Barbicas Construction Co., as a Local Business Preference under
41 Section 177.03 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, for the 2021 Summit
42 County 441 Asphalt Concrete (448) Resurfacing Program-South, in an amount not to exceed
43 \$1,713,336.91, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

45 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
46 that the aforementioned construction contract with Barbicas Construction Co. for the 2021
47 Summit County 441 Asphalt Concrete (448) Resurfacing Program-South is necessary and in the
48 best interest of the County of Summit;

50 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

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SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Barbicas Construction Co. for the 2021 Summit County 441 Asphalt Concrete (448) Resurfacing Program-South, in an amount not to exceed \$1,713,336.91, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said construction contract and any other necessary related documents.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately provide necessary pavement repairs to various County, County Alternate, Copley Township, and Springfield Township roads.

SECTION 3


Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


