7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a renewal (first of two) of a**  
8 **professional service contract with Davey Resource Group for Assessed Subdivisions,**  
9 **District 1 Evaluation, Planning and Vegetative Control Services, in Council Districts 1, 4,**  
10 **and 5, in an amount not to exceed \$99,960.00, for the Engineer, and declaring an**  
11 **emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, Davey Resource Group was hired in 2019 pursuant to Board of Control  
14 Directive No. 014-19 to evaluate the drainage systems in assessed subdivisions in Subdivision  
15 District 1 (northern Summit County townships, including Bath Township), for an amount not to  
16 exceed \$48,000.00; and

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18 WHEREAS, after evaluating the drainage in assessed subdivisions in District 1, Davey  
19 Resource Group was authorized by Change Order No.1 to perform work consisting of removing  
20 vegetation at the following retention/detention ponds: Ashford Glen A, B, and C, Bradford Oaks  
21 B, Charbonneau A, Estates of Bath F, Four Seasons of Bath A, King's Forest A, Red Hawk  
22 Reserve A, Reserve at Kensington A & B, Royal Meadows A, and Southridge Estates A, for an  
23 amount not to exceed \$45,000.00 (for a cumulative increase of 93.75%); and

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25 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2019-427, which  
26 confirmed the award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1; and

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28 WHEREAS, the Engineer proposed entering into Change Order 2, which would authorize  
29 Davey Resource Group to dredge the Reserve at Kensington Basin "B" and place rip-rap at  
30 outlet pipes to prevent erosion; and

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32 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2020-153, which  
33 confirmed the award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 2, for an amount not to  
34 exceed \$18,680.00 (a cumulative increase of 132.67%), for a total contract amount not to exceed  
35 \$111,680.00; and

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37 WHEREAS, the Engineer wishes to renew the professional service contract with Davey  
38 Resource Group for biomass removal as a continuation of vegetation control services at 20 wet  
39 and 17 dry stormwater retention basins in 18 assessed subdivisions; and

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41 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its April 7, 2021 meeting, awarded a renewal (first  
42 of two) to the professional service contract with Davey Resource Group for Assessed  
43 Subdivisions District 1 Evaluation, Planning and Vegetative Control Services, in Council  
44 Districts 1, 4, and 5, in an amount not to exceed \$99,960.00, subject to confirmation by this  
45 Council; and

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47 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
48 that the aforementioned renewal (first of two) to the professional service contract with Davey  
49 Resource Group is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

6 The award by the Board of Control of a renewal (first of two) to a professional service  
7 contract with the Davey Resource Group for Assessed Subdivisions District 1 Evaluation,  
8 Planning and Vegetative Control Services, in Council Districts 1, 4, and 5, in an amount not to  
9 exceed \$99,960.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said  
10 professional contract and any other necessary related documents.

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12 SECTION 2

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14 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
15 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately  
16 provides for necessary Evaluation, Planning and Vegetative Control Services for Assessed  
17 Subdivisions in Council Districts 1, 4, and 5.

19 SECTION 3

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21 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
22 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
23 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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25 SECTION 4

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27 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
28 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
29 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
30 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
31 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
