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7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to repay Community Corrections Act grant funds**
8 **to the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction in the total amount of**
9 **\$110,760.83, for the Executive’s Department of Law and Risk Management – Division of**
10 **Public Safety, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, Summit County annually receives Community Corrections Act (“CCA”) funding from the State of Ohio, Department of Rehabilitation and Correction (“ODRC”) to support community corrections programs; and

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16 WHEREAS, in the 1990’s ODRC provided seed funds in amount of 1/12th of the CCA award for counties to utilize as a stop gap measure in the event that funding was delayed from the State and which funding was to be carried over the from year to year; and

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20 WHEREAS, the ODRC is now recalling all of the 1/12th account funding, which totals \$102,296.24 for Summit County; and

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23 WHEREAS, through this financial audit, ODRC also found that between the years of 2013 – 2020, Summit County, through its contract with Oriana House, underspent \$8,464.59 in CCA grant funding; and

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27 WHEREAS, the County is now responsible for repayment of CCA funding to the State of Ohio, Department of Rehabilitation and Correction in a total amount of \$110,760.83; and

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30 WHEREAS, it has been determined that Oriana House, Inc., as a recipient of some of these funds, is responsible for a portion of the repayment in the amount of \$49,324.75, which will be paid to the County; and

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34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

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37 SECTION 1

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39 The Executive is hereby authorized to repay Community Corrections Act grant funds to the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction in the total amount of \$110,760.83 and the Executive is further authorized to execute any necessary related documents to accomplish the repayment.

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44 SECTION 2

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46 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to close all prior grant program periods.

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6 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
7 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
8 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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10 SECTION 4

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12 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
13 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
14 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
15 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
16 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


