### SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with AT&T to provide 9-1-1 call handling services for the Sheriff's Office and City of Akron Police Department dispatch operations, in an amount not to exceed \$997,626.83, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said purchase contract and any necessary related documents.

### **SECTION 2**

The Executive is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Akron, to reimburse the County for 58% of the cost of the purchase contract, in the amount of \$578,623.56, and any other necessary related documents.

# **SECTION 3**

This Council hereby makes the following declaration of official intent under United States Treasury Regulations for purposes of Sections 103 and 141 to 150 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (the "Internal Revenue Code"). This Council declares, on behalf of the County, that it reasonably expects the expenditures related to the acquisition of equipment along with the costs for acquiring, designing, constructing, equipping and any other expenses related to the Combined 911 Dispatch Center will be reimbursed with the proceeds of the bonds (as defined in Section 150 of the Internal Revenue Code). The maximum principal amount of bonds expected to be issued for the purpose described in this Section 2 is not to exceed \$15,000,000.00.

# **SECTION 4**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately update 9-1-1 call handling services.

### **SECTION 5**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

# **SECTION 6**

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
