WHEREAS, pursuant to the Cooperative Agreement, the current operating reserve fund and capital reserve fund for the Authority Property will offset ACH's cost to purchase the Authority Property and County Property, to the extent neither are used to pay a portion of the County Property Improvements, and the County will receive the balance in each fund upon the closing of the sale of the Authority Property and County Property to ACH; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines that the transactions set forth in the Cooperative Agreement will further the public health, safety and welfare, and promote and support development in the County; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit, to authorize the Executive to execute a Cooperative Agreement and all other agreements and documents necessary to consummate the transactions set forth in the Cooperative Agreement; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

This Council hereby authorizes the Executive to execute a Cooperative Agreement with the DFA, the City and ACH, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, together with all other agreements and documents necessary to consummate the transactions contemplated in the Cooperative Agreement, and any necessary modifications or amendments thereto, upon terms substantially similar to and not materially adverse to the County, that are otherwise consistent with the Cooperative Agreement.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to timely authorize the execution of the Cooperative Agreement so that the necessary County Property Improvements and subsequent sale of the Authority Property and County Property can proceed as quickly as possible and without undue delay.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
