A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Stephen Campbell Associates to provide 9-1-1 call logging and recording services for the Sheriff's Office and City of Akron Police Department, in an amount not to exceed \$263,553.00, and authorizing the Executive to execute an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Akron for division of the cost of the services, for the Executive's Department of Law and Risk Management – Division of Public Safety, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County and the City of Akron ("City") have need of acquiring updated call handling and logging services and hardware for their dispatch operations and have agreed that the call logging and recording services will be purchased from Steven Campbell Associates; and

WHEREAS, project costs will be shared proportionally by use between the Sheriff's Office and the City; and

WHEREAS, this project is exempt from standard bidding procedures in accordance with Codified Ordinance 177.07(a)(14); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held May 19, 2021, awarded a purchase contract with Stephen Campbell Associates to provide 9-1-1 call logging and recording services for the Sheriff's Office and City of Akron Police Department for their dispatch operations, in an amount not to exceed \$263,553.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Executive intends to issue general obligation bonds to finance and/or reimburse costs for this project, with the repayment of said bonds funded through agreements with participating communities and potentially a council of governments, representing many of these communities; and

WHEREAS, to set forth the responsibilities of the County and the City for payment of the expenses of the services, it is necessary for Council to authorize the Executive to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the City; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned purchase contract with Stephen Campbell Associates and intergovernmental agreement with the City are necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

The Executive is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Akron, to reimburse the County for 50% of the cost of the purchase contract, in the amount of \$131,776.5, and any other necessary related documents.

SECTION 3

This Council hereby makes the following declaration of official intent under United States Treasury Regulations for purposes of Sections 103 and 141 to 150 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (the "Internal Revenue Code"). This Council declares, on behalf of the County, that it reasonably expects the expenditures related to the acquisition of equipment along with the costs for acquiring, designing, constructing, equipping and any other expenses related to the Combined 911 Dispatch Center will be reimbursed with the proceeds of the bonds (as defined in Section 150 of the Internal Revenue Code). The maximum principal amount of bonds expected to be issued for the purpose described in this Section 2 is not to exceed \$15,000,000.00.

SECTION 4

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately update 9-1-1 call logging and recording services.

SECTION 5

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
