8 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to advertise for bids for the Akron-Peninsula Road**
9 **Relocation Project, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$1,120,000.00 for the Engineer**
10 **and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
13 requires this Council's authorization to advertise for bids for said Project; and

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15 WHEREAS, the Engineer secured a \$1,000,000.00 grant from the Ohio Public Works
16 Commission for the Akron-Peninsula Road Relocation Project and is administering the project
17 on behalf of the Village of Peninsula; and

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19 WHEREAS, the Engineer estimates the cost of the improved system and installation to be
20 \$1,120,000.00 and

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22 WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2021-130 authorized the Executive to enter into an
23 agreement outlining financial and administrative responsibilities with the Village of Peninsula
24 for the above referenced project; and

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26 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
27 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
28 advertise for bids for the Akron-Peninsula Road Relocation Project;

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30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
31 of Ohio, that:

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33 SECTION 1

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35 The Executive is hereby authorized to advertise for the Akron-Peninsula Road Relocation
36 Project at an estimated cost not to exceed \$1,120,000.00.

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38 SECTION 2

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40 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
41 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it will allow the
42 County to repair and reopen a critical road for Summit County motorists.

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44 SECTION 3

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46 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
47 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
48 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


