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7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a Temporary Assistance to**  
8 **Needy Families Agreement with Greenleaf Family Center, to provide child safety education**  
9 **services and to distribute child safety and basic needs items, to pregnant women and**  
10 **parents of young children, from 7/1/21 through 9/30/22, in an amount not to exceed**  
11 **\$250,000.00, for the Executive’s Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an**  
12 **emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the Executive’s Department of Jobs (“DJFS”) seeks to enter into a  
15 Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (“TANF”) agreement with Greenleaf Family Center to  
16 provide child safety education services and to distribute child safety and basic needs items, to  
17 pregnant women and parents of young children; and

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19 WHEREAS, the provided education services will include basic safety awareness and  
20 instructions, along with resource and referral information regarding child safety and basic  
21 parenting needs. Child safety and basic needs items will include the most requested and needed  
22 items by this population from local social service providers; and

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24 WHEREAS, Greenleaf Family Center will serve clientele from their existing Moms &  
25 Babies First pregnancy support services and will work with the Full Term First Birthday local  
26 collaborative to expand services to pregnant women and parents of young children throughout  
27 Summit County; and

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29 WHEREAS, the Greenleaf Family Center has provided services for various Summit  
30 County agencies and Courts since 2009; and

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32 WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to enter into a TANF Agreement with Greenleaf  
33 Family Center to provide the above referenced services; and

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35 WHEREAS, this agreement will be funded utilizing TANF funds; and

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37 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held June 9, 2021, awarded a TANF  
38 Agreement with Greenleaf Family Center, which is exempt from competitive bidding due to the  
39 provider’s subgrantee status, to provide child safety education services and to distribute child  
40 safety and basic needs items, to pregnant women and parents of young children, from 7/1/21  
41 through 9/30/22, in an amount not to exceed \$250,000.00, subject to confirmation by this  
42 Council; and

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44 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
45 that the aforementioned TANF Agreement with Greenleaf Family Center is necessary and in the  
46 best interest of the County of Summit;

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48 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

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4 SECTION 1

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6 The award by the Board of Control of a Temporary Assistance to Needy Families  
7 (“TANF”) Agreement with Greenleaf Family Center to provide child safety education services  
8 and to distribute child safety and basic needs items, to pregnant women and parents of young  
9 children, from 7/1/21 through 9/30/22, in an amount not to exceed \$250,000.00, is hereby  
10 confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said agreement and any necessary  
11 related documents.

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13 SECTION 2

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15 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety, and  
16 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to provide to provide  
17 child safety education services and to distribute child safety and basic needs items, to pregnant  
18 women and parents of young children beginning on 7/1/21.

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20 SECTION 3

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22 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
23 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
24 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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26 SECTION 4

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28 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
29 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
30 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
