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8 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a Temporary Assistance to**
9 **Needy Families Agreement with Emmanuel Christian Academy for Science Technology**
10 **Engineering Arts and Math (STEAM) Summer Enrichment Camp Services, from 5/1/21**
11 **through 8/30/21, in an amount not to exceed \$65,000.00, for the Executive's Department of**
12 **Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the Executive's Department of Jobs ("DJFS") seeks to enter into a
15 Temporary Assistance to Needy Families ("TANF") agreement with Emmanuel Christian
16 Academy for Science Technology Engineering Arts and Math ("STEAM") Summer Enrichment
17 Camp Services for up to eighty kindergarten through 8th grade students; and

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19 WHEREAS, services provided will include academic, social and personal enrichment
20 opportunities designed to reinforce STEAM concepts learned during the school year, expand
21 general knowledge and social skills, and challenges students for the upcoming school year; and

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23 WHEREAS, Emmanuel Christian Academy, in collaboration with Summit Education
24 Initiate, will assess students at the start and end of the program to determine its academic
25 effectiveness; and

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27 WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to enter into a TANF Agreement with Emmanuel
28 Christian Academy to provide the above referenced services; and

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30 WHEREAS, this agreement will be funded utilizing TANF funds; and

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32 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held June 9, 2021, awarded a TANF
33 Agreement with Emmanuel Christian Academy, which is exempt from competitive bidding due
34 to the provider's subgrantee status, to provide Science Technology Engineering Arts and Math
35 ("STEAM") Summer Enrichment Camp Services for up to eighty kindergarten through 8th grade
36 students, from 5/1/21 through 8/30/21, in an amount not to exceed \$65,000.00, subject to
37 confirmation by this Council; and

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39 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
40 that the aforementioned TANF Agreement with Emmanuel Christian Academy is necessary and
41 in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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43 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
44 of Ohio, that:

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4 SECTION 1

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6 The award by the Board of Control of a Temporary Assistance to Needy Families
7 ("TANF") Agreement with Emmanuel Christian Academy to provide Science Technology
8 Engineering Arts and Math ("STEAM") Summer Enrichment Camp Services for up to eighty
9 kindergarten through 8th grade students, from 5/1/21 through 8/30/21, in an amount not to exceed
10 \$65,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said
11 agreement and any necessary related documents.

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13 SECTION 2

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15 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety, and
16 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
17 provide STEAM Summer Enrichment Camp Services for up to eighty kindergarten through 8th
18 grade students.


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22 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take


