7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept**  
8 **Federal Surface Transportation Block Grant funds programmed by the Akron**  
9 **Metropolitan Area Transportation Study for the Canton Road Resurfacing Project, at a**  
10 **total project cost not to exceed \$660,000.00, with a local cash match of \$132,000.00, located**  
11 **in Springfield Township, in Council District 8, for the Engineer and declaring an**  
12 **emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (“AMATS”) announced  
15 a special round of funding for resurfacing projects on April 22, 2021; and

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17 WHEREAS, the Engineer identified 0.72 miles of Canton Road, between Pontius Road  
18 and Tisen Road, as a resurfacing project that met AMATS project criteria and guidelines; and

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20 WHEREAS, the Canton Road Resurfacing Project was the highest ranking project out of  
21 the thirty-six applications for the special round of funding; and

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23 WHEREAS, the Surface Transportation Block Grant funds, programmed through  
24 AMATS, will provide up to 80% of the construction costs for the project, with a 20% local cash  
25 match required, to be paid for out of local Motor Vehicle and Gas Tax funds; and

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27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
28 of Ohio, that:

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30 SECTION 1

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32 The Executive, on behalf of the County of Summit, is hereby authorized to execute any  
33 documents necessary to accept Federal Surface Transportation (“AMATS”) Block Grant funds  
34 programmed by the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study for the Canton Road  
35 Resurfacing Project.

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37 SECTION 2

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39 That the County of Summit acknowledges and understands the AMATS “Funding Policy  
40 Guidelines” and confirms to the best of its knowledge that the information contained in the  
41 project application is accurate, that it intends to diligently pursue that project, and that a local  
42 share is available to match federal funds.

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44 SECTION 3

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46 The Clerk of Council is instructed to provide two certified copies of this Resolution to the  
47 Engineer, for submission to AMATS as part of the funding applications.

6 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and  
7 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reasons that it will  
8 immediately allow the County to obtain grants for a needed road improvement.

12 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight (8) members, it shall take  
13 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
14 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

16 SECTION 6

18 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
19 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
20 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
21 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
22 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


