7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**  
8 **Kimble Recycling and Disposal, Inc., for the disposal of sludge from both the Fishcreek**  
9 **Wastewater Treatment Plant #25, located in Stow, in Council District 3, and the Upper**  
10 **Tuscarawas Wastewater Treatment Plant #36, located in Springfield Township, in Council**  
11 **District 8, to a solid waste landfill, for a one-year term, from 7/1/21 to 6/30/22, in an**  
12 **amount not to exceed \$304,236.00, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer**  
13 **Services, and declaring an emergency.**

14  
15 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2021-118, which authorized  
16 the Executive to advertise for bids for the disposal of sludge from both the Fishcreek Wastewater  
17 Treatment Plant ("WWTP") #25, located in the City of Stow, and the Upper Tuscarawas WWTP  
18 #36, located in Springfield Township, in Council Districts 3 and 8, respectively, to a solid waste  
19 landfill, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$315,000.00; and

21 WHEREAS, the Executive selected Kimble Recycling and Disposal, Inc. as the lowest  
22 responsive and responsible bidder for the disposal of sludge from both the WWTP #25, located  
23 in the City of Stow, and the Upper Tuscarawas WWTP #36, located in Springfield Township, in  
24 Council Districts 3 and 8, respectively; and

26 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held June 9, 2021, awarded a purchase  
27 contract with Kimble Recycling and Disposal, Inc., for the disposal of sludge from both the  
28 Fishcreek WWTP #25, located in the City of Stow, and the Upper Tuscarawas WWTP #36,  
29 located in Springfield Township, in Council Districts 3 and 8, respectively, to a solid waste  
30 landfill, for a one-year term, from 7/1/21 to 6/30/22, for an amount not to exceed \$304,236.00,  
31 subject to confirmation by this Council; and

33 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
34 that the aforementioned purchase contract with Kimble Recycling and Disposal, Inc. is necessary  
35 and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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37 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

42 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Kimble Recycling and  
43 Disposal, Inc., for the disposal of sludge from both the Fishcreek Wastewater Treatment Plan  
44 ("WWTP") #25, located in the City of Stow, and the Upper Tuscarawas WWTP #36, located in  
45 Springfield Township, in Council Districts 3 and 8, respectively, to a solid waste landfill, for a  
46 one-year term, from 7/1/21 to 6/30/22, for an amount not to exceed \$304,236.00, is hereby  
47 confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said purchase contract and any  
48 other necessary related documents.

4 SECTION 2

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6 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare  
7 of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide for  
8 the removal and disposal of sludge from the City of Stow and Springfield Township.

12 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
13 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
14 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

16 SECTION 4

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18 It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating  
19 to the adoption of the Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
20 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
21 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
22 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


