7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute a subgrant agreement with the Ohio**
8 **Department of Job and Family Services for grants received by the Prosecutor’s Child**
9 **Support Enforcement Agency during State Fiscal Years 2022 and 2023, for the period**
10 **7/1/21 through 6/30/23, for the Prosecutor-Child Support Enforcement Agency, and**
11 **declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, Section 5101.21 of the Ohio Revised Code provides, commencing 7/1/08,
14 that the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services (“ODJFS”) may only make grants to
15 counties through subgrant agreements described in that section; and

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17 WHEREAS, in conformance with Section 5101.21 of the Ohio Revised Code, ODJFS
18 developed a standard subgrant agreement to be executed by the commissioners, or in the case of
19 a charter county, the executive, of each county prior to receiving ODJFS grant funds; and

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21 WHEREAS, the Prosecutor’s Child Support Enforcement Agency (“CSEA”) has
22 received from ODJFS the standard subgrant agreement for State Fiscal Years (“SFY”) 2022 and
23 2023, for the period 7/1/21 through 6/30/23, that sets forth the rights and responsibilities of
24 ODJFS and CSEA in relation to any grant that is awarded for SFY 2022 and 2023; and

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26 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
27 that is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
28 execute said subgrant agreement with ODJFS for SFY 2022 and 2023;

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30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
31 of Ohio, that;

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33 SECTION 1

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35 The Executive is authorized to execute a subgrant agreement with the Ohio Department
36 of Job and Family Services (“ODJFS”) for grants received by the Prosecutor’s Child Support
37 Enforcement Agency (“CSEA”) for State Fiscal Years (“SFY”) 2022 and 2023, for the period
38 7/1/21 through 6/30/23. The Executive is hereby authorized to execute said subgrant agreement,
39 a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated fully herein, with such
40 modifications and revisions as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of said subgrant
41 agreement and not substantially adverse to the County, all of which shall be conclusively
42 evidenced by the execution thereof by the Executive.

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44 SECTION 2

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46 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare
47 of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it is necessary to
48 immediately authorize the Executive to execute said subgrant agreement so that CSEA is eligible
49 to be awarded grant funds from ODJFS for SFY 2022 and 2023 effective 7/1/21.


