7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of professional service**  
8 **contracts between certain providers and the County’s Department of Job and Family**  
9 **Services and the Summit and Medina Workforce Area Council of Governments, to provide**  
10 **in-school and out-of-school youth employment and educational services under the**  
11 **Comprehensive Case Management and Employment Program, for the period 7/1/21 to**  
12 **6/30/22, with two options to renew for a one year term, in a total amount not to exceed**  
13 **\$2,038,005.49, for the Executive’s Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring**  
14 **an emergency.**

15  
16 WHEREAS, Ohio consolidated the delivery of Workforce Investment Opportunity Act  
17 (“WIOA”) and Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (“TANF”) funded youth services  
18 under the Comprehensive Case Management and Employment Program (“CCMEP”); and

19  
20 WHEREAS, Ohio requires its Local Workforce Areas to work collaboratively with  
21 County Departments of Job and Family Services to administer CCMEP services; and

22  
23 WHEREAS, after issuing a request for proposals and evaluating the responses, the  
24 Executive’s Department of Job and Family Services (“DJFS”) seeks to jointly renew agreements  
25 with Summit and Medina Workforce Area Council of Governments (“SAMWA COG”) and  
26 three providers for CCMEP youth workforce development services; and

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28 WHEREAS, CCMEP provides employment and training services to low-income, in-  
29 school and out-of-school, youth aged 14 to 24, based on a comprehensive assessment of  
30 employment and training needs, as well as a basic skills assessment; and

32 WHEREAS, CCMEP participants are provided services to support goals outlined in their  
33 Individual Opportunity Plan (“IOP”), which may include objectives, such as, obtaining a high  
34 school diploma, job placement, work experience and other identified supportive services, such  
35 as, childcare and transportation; and

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37 WHEREAS, CCMEP services are provided with the goals of assisting at-risk youth in  
38 achieving major educational goals, skill development and/or employment; and

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40 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held May 26, 2021, awarded  
41 professional service contracts between certain providers and DJFS and the SAMWA COG to  
42 provide in-school and out-of-school youth employment and educational services under the  
43 CCMEP for the period 7/1/21 to 6/30/22, with two options to renew for a one year term, in a  
44 total amount not to exceed \$2,038,005.49, as more fully set forth on Exhibit A, attached hereto  
45 and incorporated herein by reference, subject to confirmation by Council; and

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47 WHEREAS, as required by the CCMEP, said professional service contracts will be  
48 funded by both WIOA funding through the SAMWA COG and TANF funding through DJFS;

4 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
5 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to enter into the aforementioned  
6 professional service contracts;

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8 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
9 of Ohio, that:

11 SECTION 1

12  
13 The award by the Board of Control of professional service contracts between certain  
14 providers and the County's Department of Job and Family Services and the Summit and Medina  
15 Workforce Area Council of Governments to provide in-school and out-of-school youth  
16 employment and educational services under the Comprehensive Case Management and  
17 Employment Program, for the period 7/1/21 to 6/30/22, with two options to renew for a one year  
18 term, in a total amount not to exceed \$2,038,005.49, as more fully set forth on Exhibit A,  
19 attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is  
20 hereby authorized to execute said contracts and any other necessary related documents.

22 SECTION 2

23  
24 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
25 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
26 provide in-school and out-of-school youth employment and educational services effective 7/1/21.

28 SECTION 3

30 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
31 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
32 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

34 SECTION 4

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36 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
37 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
38 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
39 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
40 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
