7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute four Local Public Agency agreements**  
8 **with the State of Ohio, through the Department of Transportation, for various projects**  
9 **located in Council Districts 1, 5, and 8, with an estimated total cost not to exceed**  
10 **\$3,328,000.00, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

11  
12 WHEREAS, the Engineer's Office has received grant awards for the resurfacing of  
13 Cleveland-Massillon Road from the city of Norton line to 0.4 miles north of Minor Road (Project  
14 Identification Number 108467), the resurfacing of Swartz Road from South Main Street to 0.1  
15 miles east of Glenmount Avenue (Project Identification Number 113176), the improvement of  
16 the intersection of Valley View Road and Olde 8 Road, including a new traffic signal (Project  
17 Identification Number 112797), and the replacement of the Granger Road Bridge over Yellow  
18 Creek (Project Identification 112848), (herein after referred to as the "Projects"); and

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20 WHEREAS, the estimated total cost of the Projects is \$3,328,000.00; and

21  
22 WHEREAS, various federal grant funds have been awarded in an amount not to exceed  
23 \$2,675,760.00, to cover up to 80% of the Projects' costs, with the Engineer's Office being  
24 responsible to provide the remaining funds necessary for the Projects' costs; and

26 WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Transportation  
27 ("ODOT"), and the Engineer desire to enter into Local Public Agency ("LPA") agreements, to  
28 confirm the Projects' costs and to designate the County of Summit as the lead agency for  
29 administration of the Projects; and

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31 WHEREAS, Sections 5501.03(c) and 5543.01 of the Ohio Revised Code, as well as  
32 Article II, Section 2.03(5) of the County of Summit Charter allow execution of such LPA  
33 agreements, subject to the approval of this Council; and

34  
35 WHEREAS, said LPA Agreements will provide (i) that the estimated cost of the Projects  
36 (ii) that ODOT shall provide to the County as the LPA up to 80% of eligible Project costs, in  
37 Surface Transportation Block Grant funds, Federal Ohio County Engineer's Association of Ohio  
38 Bridge funds, and Federal Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality funds, and (iii) that the  
39 County, as the LPA, will provide the remaining funds necessary to pay for the Projects' costs;  
40 and

42 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, by reviewing all pertinent information,  
43 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to  
44 execute the aforementioned LPA agreements with ODOT;

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46 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
47 of Ohio, that:

4 SECTION 1

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6 The Executive is hereby authorized to execute Local Public Agency (“LPA”) agreements  
7 with the State of Ohio, through the Department of Transportation (“ODOT”), for the resurfacing  
8 of Cleveland-Massillon Road from the city of Norton line to 0.4 miles north of Minor Road  
9 (Project Identification Number 108467), the resurfacing of Swartz Road from South Main Street  
10 to 0.1 miles east of Glenmount Avenue (Project Identification Number 113176), the  
11 improvement of the intersection of Valley View Road and Olde 8 Road, including a new traffic  
12 signal (Project Identification Number 112797), and the replacement of the Granger Road Bridge  
13 over Yellow Creek (Project Identification 112848), (the “Projects”) located in Council Districts  
14 1, 5, and 8, a copy of each LPA agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated fully  
15 herein, with such modifications and revisions as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of said  
16 LPA agreements and not substantially adverse to the County, all of which shall be conclusively  
17 evidenced by the execution thereof by the Executive. Upon federal  
18 authorization from ODOT, the County may commence the administration of the Projects, with  
19 the award of the Projects subject to applicable Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit,  
20 said Ordinances requiring authorization of such an award by the Board of Control and/or County  
21 Council.

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23 SECTION 2

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25 The LPA agreements will show the Projects’ descriptions and costs which are broken  
26 down as follows:

- 27  
28 1. Cleveland-Massillon Road Resurfacing Project Phase 1, located in Copley Township,  
29 Project Identification Number 108467, total cost of \$1,100,000, with Surface  
30 Transportation Block Grant funding covering up to 80% of construction costs, up to  
31 \$700,000.00, for construction in 2022.
- 32 2. Swartz Road Resurfacing Project, located in Coventry Township, Project Identification  
33 Number 113176, total cost of \$325,000.00 with Surface Transportation Block Grant  
34 funding covering up to 80% of construction costs, up to \$260,000.00, for construction in  
35 2023.
- 36 3. Valley View Road and Olde 8 Road Intersection Improvement, located in Northfield  
37 Center Township, Project Identification number 112797, total cost of \$625,000.00, with  
38 Federal Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality funding covering up to 80% of  
39 construction costs, up to \$500,000.00, for construction in 2023.
- 40 4. Granger Road Bridge Replacement, located in Bath Township, Project Identification  
41 Number 112848, total cost of \$1,278,000.00 with Local Bridge Program funding  
42 covering 80% of the construction costs, up to \$1,215,760.00 for construction in 2025.

44 SECTION 3

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46 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
47 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately  
48 completes a prerequisite to accept funds needed for safe and convenient travel within the County.

16 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


