7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with**  
8 **Karvo Companies, Inc. for the Smith Road Resurfacing Program, at a total project cost not**  
9 **to exceed \$845,856.64, with a local cash match of \$169,171.33, located in Bath Township**  
10 **and the City of Akron, in Council District 4, for the Engineer and declaring an emergency.**

11  
12 WHEREAS, the Smith Road Resurfacing Program (the "Project") will resurface Smith  
13 Road from just east of Lake of the Woods Boulevard to the east side of Sand Run Road which  
14 needs repair and resurfacing; and

15  
16 WHEREAS, Surface Transportation Block Grant funds will provide up to 80% of the  
17 construction costs for the Project, with a 20% local cash match required, to be paid for out of  
18 local Motor Vehicle and Gas Tax funds; and

19  
20 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-416, which authorized  
21 the Executive to advertise for bids for the Project, as part of bridge engineering and construction  
22 projects, and pavement maintenance projects, for the Engineer's 2021 Capital Improvements  
23 Program, and federal and state funded projects, for an estimated total cost not to exceed  
24 \$9,117,500.00; and

25  
26 WHEREAS, said projects were approved as part of the Capital Improvements Program  
27 for 2021-2026 by Resolution No. 2021-037; and

28  
29 WHEREAS, following the receipt and review of bids, the Executive has proposed  
30 entering into a construction contract with Karvo Companies, Inc. for the Project, in an amount  
31 not to exceed \$845,856.64, with a local cash match of \$169,171.33; and

33 WHEREAS, the contract total will be broken down by political subdivision as follows  
34 with each subdivision responsible for directly paying Karvo Companies, Inc.:

36 Federal Surface Transportation Block Grant: \$676,685.31  
37 County: \$135,337.06  
38 Akron: \$33,834.27

40 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on June 23, 2021, awarded a  
41 construction contract with Karvo Companies, Inc., as the lowest responsive and responsible  
42 bidder, for the Project, in an amount not to exceed \$845,856.64, with a local cash match of  
43 \$169,171.33, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

44  
45 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
46 that the aforementioned construction contract with Karvo Companies, Inc. for the Project is  
47 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

49 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of

6 The award by the Board of Control of construction contract with Karvo Companies, Inc.  
7 for the Smith Road Resurfacing Program, in an amount not to exceed \$845,856.64, with a local  
8 cash match of \$169,171.33, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to  
9 execute said construction contract and any other necessary related documents.

11 SECTION 2

12  
13 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
14 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately  
15 provide necessary pavement repairs to Smith Road.

17 SECTION 3

19 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
20 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
21 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

25 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
26 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
27 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,

29 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
