12 13 14	WHEREAS, the existing HVAC and plumbing systems are original to the Jail when it was constructed in 1987 and expanded in 1993; and
15 16 17 18	WHEREAS, the cooling tower failed, and a temporary chiller is being used to support the cooling system for the Jail so an upgrade to the entire system is needed to provide proper building conditions for the inmates and staff at the Jail; and
19 20 21 22 23 24	WHEREAS, the scope of the Summit County Jail HVAC and Plumbing Project (the "Project") is to replace both the heating and cooling plants, replace the 96 air handlers and upgrade the temperature control systems. The plumbing fixtures will also be upgraded to water savings devices to reduce the water bills; and
25 26 27	WHEREAS, it is expected that the cost of said project will be reimbursed through the issuance of general obligation bonds at a future date; and
28 29 30 31	WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-318, which authorized the Executive to execute a professional design contract with DLZ, Inc. to provide design work for the Project, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$612,800.00; and

SECTION 2	

This Council hereby makes the following declaration of official intent under United States Treasury Regulations for purposes of Sections 103 and 141 to 150 of the Internal Revenue code of 1986 (the "Internal Revenue Code"): This Council declares, on behalf of the County, that it reasonably expects the expenditures related to the replacement and upgrade of the existing HVAC and plumbing systems at the Summit County Jail will be reimbursed with the proceeds of bonds (as defined in Section 150 of the Internal Revenue Code). The maximum principal amount of bonds expected to be issued for the purpose described in this section 2 is not to exceed \$10,000,000.

SECTION 3

ENACTED EFFECTIVE

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the Executive to immediately a necessary upgrade to the HVAC and plumbing at the Summit County Jail.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
