7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute, subject to the approval of the Board of**
8 **Control, a Temporary Assistance to Needy Families Agreement with Early Childhood**
9 **Resource Center, as a Best Practical Source, to provide summer camp reimbursement**
10 **services, from 6/1/21 through 9/30/21, in an amount not to exceed \$250,000.00, for the**
11 **Executive’s Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Executive’s Department of Jobs and Family Services (“DJFS”) seeks to
14 enter into a Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (“TANF”) agreement with Early
15 Childhood Resource Center, to provide for summer camp reimbursement services; and

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17 WHEREAS, under this proposed agreement, Early Childhood Resource Center will
18 coordinate a county-wide summer camp reimbursement program, which will refund camp fees to
19 up to 800 TANF eligible families that have paid fees to licensed summer camps; and

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21 WHEREAS, Early Childhood Resource Center will provide direct reimbursement
22 payments to families and will also make direct payments to camps on behalf of families that
23 cannot pay fees pending reimbursements. Early Childhood Resource Center will also act as a
24 referral resource to assist families in identifying licensed summer camp opportunities which meet
25 specific care needs; and

27 WHEREAS, Early Childhood Resource Center is considered the Best Practical Source
28 for these services as it is the only local provider contracted with the state to provide
29 comprehensive referral services regarding all licensed child care centers, afterschool programs
30 and summer camps, in Summit County; and

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32 WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to enter into a TANF Agreement with Early
33 Childhood Resource Center, as a Best Practical Source, to provide the above referenced services;
34 and

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36 WHEREAS, it is necessary to authorize the Executive to execute, subject to the approval
37 of the Board of Control, said agreement with Early Childhood Resource Center, as a Best
38 Practical Source; and

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40 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
41 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
42 execute, subject to the approval of the Board of Control, the aforementioned TANF Agreement
43 with Early Childhood Resource Center, as a Best Practical Source;

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4 SECTION 1

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6 The Executive is hereby authorized to execute, subject to the approval of the Board of
7 Control, a Temporary Assistance to Needy Families Agreement with Early Childhood Resource
8 Center, as a Best Practical Source, to provide for summer camp reimbursement services, from
9 6/1/21 through 9/30/21, in an amount not to exceed \$250,000.00

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11 SECTION 2

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13 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety, and
14 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to provide summer
15 camp reimbursement services as expeditiously as possible.

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17 SECTION 3

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19 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
20 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
21 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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23 SECTION 4

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25 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
26 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
27 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
28 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
29 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


