7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a**  
8 **Temporary Assistance to Needy Families Agreement with Emmanuel Christian Academy**  
9 **for Entrepreneurship Summer Camp Services, from 5/1/21 through 8/30/21, in an amount**  
10 **not to exceed \$78,225.24, (for a cumulative increase of 156%) for a total amount not to**  
11 **exceed \$128,225.24, for the Executive’s Department of Job and Family Services, and**  
12 **declaring an emergency.**

13  
14 WHEREAS, pursuant to Directive No. 076-21, the Board of Control previously awarded  
15 a Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (“TANF”) Agreement with Emmanuel Christian  
16 Academy for Entrepreneurship Summer Camp Services, from 5/1/21 through 8/30/21, in an  
17 amount not to exceed \$50,000.00, for the Executive’s Department of Jobs and Family Services  
18 (“DJFS”); and

20 WHEREAS, the Executive seeks to amend the agreement with Emmanuel Christian  
21 Academy which provides entrepreneurship summer camp services which introduce students to  
22 self-sufficiency though development of business opportunities and life skills. These services are  
23 offered to youth aged 9 to 15 years old via classroom workshops, guest speakers, group projects  
24 and field trips. Training topics includes business planning, securing financing, marketing,  
25 financial literacy, development of positive life skills, communication, negotiation and mediation  
26 skills development; and

28 WHEREAS, this Change Order is necessary due to increasing staff salaries to provide a  
29 staff composed of teaching professionals and due to enhancing services offered to the students by  
30 adding recreational and educational workshops and fieldtrips to the existing curriculum; and

32 WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to enter into Change Order No. 1 to the TANF  
33 Agreement with Emmanuel Christian Academy to provide the above referenced additional  
34 services; and

36 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held June 23, 2021, awarded Change  
37 Order No. 1 to the TANF Agreement with Emmanuel Christian Academy, for Entrepreneurship  
38 Summer Camp Services, from 5/1/21 through 8/30/21, in an amount not to exceed \$78,225.24,  
39 (for a cumulative increase of 156%) for a total amount not to exceed \$128,225.24, subject to  
40 confirmation by this Council; and

42 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
43 that Change Order No. 1 to the aforementioned TANF Agreement with Emmanuel Christian  
44 Academy is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

6 The award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a Temporary Assistance to  
7 Needy Families ("TANF") Agreement with Emmanuel Christian Academy to provide for  
8 Entrepreneurship Summer Camp Services, from 5/1/21 through 8/30/21, in an amount not to  
9 exceed \$78,225.24, (for a cumulative increase of 156%) for a total amount not to exceed  
10 \$128,225.24, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said Change  
11 Order and any necessary related documents.

15 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety, and  
16 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
17 confirm the award of a necessary change order to the TANF Agreement in order to immediately  
18 provide additional Entrepreneurship Summer Camp Services to local youth.

23 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
24 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
