7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a Temporary Assistance to**  
8 **Needy Families Agreement with Akron Community Service Center & Urban League, Inc.,**  
9 **to provide Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math (STEAM) Program services,**  
10 **from 7/1/21 through 6/30/22, in an amount not to exceed \$75,000.00, for the Executive's**  
11 **Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

12  
13 WHEREAS, the Executive's Department of Jobs and Family Services ("DJFS") seeks to  
14 enter into a Temporary Assistance to Needy Families ("TANF") agreement with Akron  
15 Community Service Center & Urban League, Inc., to provide Science, Technology, Engineering,  
16 Arts and Math (STEAM) Program services; and

17  
18 WHEREAS, Executive seeks to enter an agreement with Akron Community Service  
19 Center & Urban League, Inc., for STEAM Program services for students in 3rd through 6th  
20 grades. The Program services will be offered in an afterschool classroom setting designed to  
21 enhance STEAM interest and aptitudes, utilizing the STEM NASA curriculum model; and

22  
23 WHEREAS, the STEAM Program services will include homework assistance, student  
24 engagement, student learning benchmark development and achievement, experiential learning,  
25 development of Individual Educational Programs for each student and parent meetings; and

26  
27 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-187, which  
28 authorized this Program as part of the DJFS Title XX/TANF Fiscal Year 2020 Funding  
29 Recommendations; and

30  
31 WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to enter into a TANF Agreement with Akron  
32 Community Service Center & Urban League, Inc. to provide the above referenced services; and

33  
34 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held June 23, 2021, awarded a TANF  
35 Agreement with Akron Community Service Center & Urban League, Inc., which is exempt from  
36 competitive bidding due to the provider's subgrantee status, to provide Science, Technology,  
37 Engineering, Arts and Math (STEAM) Program services, from 7/1/21 through 6/30/22, in an  
38 amount not to exceed \$75,000.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

40 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
41 that the aforementioned TANF Agreement with Akron Community Service Center & Urban  
42 League, Inc. is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

44 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

9 through 6/30/22, in an amount not to exceed \$75,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive  
10 is hereby authorized to execute said agreement and any necessary related documents.

15 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to provide STEAM  
16 Program services beginning on 7/1/21.

21 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
22 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


