A Resolution declaring the roof top HVAC coolant leak damage to the Juvenile Court Building located in the City of Akron, in Council District 2, an emergency pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(3) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, and confirming an award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Architectural Roofing Contractors, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$74,350.00, for emergency repairs to the roof, for the Executive's Department of Administrative Services-Physical Plants, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the roof top HVAC unit at the Juvenile Court Building suffered a coolant leak causing the coolant to seep into and under the roof membrane causing the roof insulation to delaminate; and

WHEREAS, the portion of the roof damaged by the coolant leak was replaced in 2019 and to maintain the roof warranty it is necessary to remove the roof membrane and insulation and replace them in their entirety as soon as possible; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held June 16, 2021, awarded a construction contract with Architectural Roofing Contractors, Inc., for an emergency repair of the damaged portion of the Juvenile Court Building roof, in an amount not to exceed \$74,350.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned repair constitutes an emergency repair under Section 177.07(a)(3) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit and further finds and determines that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to confirm an award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Architectural Roofing Contractors, Inc. for said emergency repair of the roof, in an amount not to exceed \$74,350.00;
