7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a professional service**
8 **contract with Oriana House, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for community corrections**
9 **services, for the period 7/1/21 through 6/30/23, in an amount not to exceed \$786,236.00, for**
10 **the Executive’s Department of Law and Risk Management – Division of Public Safety, and**
11 **declaring an emergency.**

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13 The Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Corrections (“ODRC”) through the
14 Community Corrections Act (“CCA”) Grant Program has renewed an award to Summit County
15 of a 408 program grant for State Fiscal Years 2022-2023 (7/1/21 - 6/30/23) in the amount of
16 \$981,240.00 to support alternative community corrections programs for misdemeanor offenders
17 in order to divert individuals from incarceration. These programs are managed by Oriana House,
18 Inc., the Summit County Sheriff and the Summit County Court of Common Pleas. Costs for
19 programming by Oriana House, Inc. are not to exceed \$786,236.00; and

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21 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2021-160, which authorized
22 the Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the above referenced
23 408 grant; and

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25 WHEREAS, Oriana House, Inc. is a Best Practical Source as they are recognized by the
26 ODRC as the service provider on the CCA Grant application and they have provided similar
27 community corrections for the County for years; and

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29 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held June 23, 2021, awarded a
30 professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for community
31 corrections services, for the period 7/1/21 through 6/30/23, in an amount not to exceed
32 \$786,236.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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34 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information,
35 that the aforementioned professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc. is necessary and in
36 the best interest of the County of Summit;

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38 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
39 of Ohio, that:

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43 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Oriana House,
44 Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for community corrections services, for the period 7/1/21

46 is hereby authorized to execute said professional service contract and any necessary related
47 documents.

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


