7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute a construction contract with Perram**
8 **Electric Inc. for the Olde 8/Twinsburg Road Traffic Signal Improvement Project, located**
9 **in Northfield Center Township, Council District 1, in an amount not to exceed \$115,650.00,**
10 **for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, Section 5553.02 of the Ohio Revised Code grants authority to locate, alter,
13 or vacate roads to a board of county commissioners; and

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15 WHEREAS, Section 5553.04 of the Ohio Revised Code establishes the procedure for
16 establishing, altering, or vacating roads; and

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18 WHEREAS, Section 305.01(b) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
19 grants this Council the authority to regulate traffic by use of traffic control devices on streets and
20 highways under County jurisdiction; and

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22 WHEREAS, the Engineer has identified a public need for a traffic signal at the
23 intersection of Olde 8/Twinsburg Road; and

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25 WHEREAS, the Olde 8/Twinsburg Road Traffic Signal Improvement Project (the
26 "Project") involves the construction of a traffic signal at the intersection of Olde 8 and
27 Twinsburg Road in Northfield Center Township, which is currently an intersection operating
28 with a two-way stop; and

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30 WHEREAS, this intersection was consistently on the top 5 high crash intersection list of
31 County-owned intersections and the Northfield Center Township Trustees agree with
32 construction of a traffic signal; and

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34 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-416, which authorized
35 the Engineer to advertise as needed for bridge engineering and construction projects, and
36 pavement maintenance projects, for the Engineer's 2021 Capital Improvements Program, and
37 federal and state funded projects, at an estimated cost not to exceed \$9,117,500.00; and

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39 WHEREAS, said projects were approved as part of the Capital Improvements Program
40 for 2021-2026 by Resolution No. 2021-037; and

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42 WHEREAS, following the receipt and review of bids, the Executive wishes to enter into
43 a construction contract with Perram Electric, Inc. for the Olde 8/Twinsburg Road Traffic Signal
44 Improvement Project, in an amount not to exceed \$115,650.00; and

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46 WHEREAS, the Olde 8/Twinsburg Road Traffic Signal Improvement Project is 90%
47 funded by Federal Safety Funds; and

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49 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held June 9, 2021, awarded a
50 construction contract with Perram Electric, Inc, as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder,
51 for the for the Olde 8/Twinsburg Road Traffic Signal Improvement Project, in an amount not to
52 exceed \$115,650.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute the aforementioned construction contract with Perram Electric, Inc.;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;

SECTION 1

The Executive is hereby authorized to execute a construction contract with Perram Electric Inc. for the Olde 8/Twinsburg Road Traffic Signal Improvement Project, in an amount not to exceed \$115.650.00, and any necessary related documents.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately make safety upgrades to an intersection with a high crash rating.

SECTION 3


Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4
