7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with**
8 **Kenmore Construction Co., Inc. for the Akron-Peninsula Road Relocation Project, in the**
9 **Village of Peninsula, in Council District 1, in an amount not to exceed \$717,574.00, for the**
10 **Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, Akron-Peninsula Road between State Route 303 and Truxell Road is owned
13 and maintained by the Village of Peninsula (“Village”). An engineer hired by the Village in
14 November of 2020, advised that the road was a danger to motorists due to an embankment slide
15 where the Cuyahoga River comes close to the roadway; and

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17 WHEREAS, the village closed the road to ensure the safety of motorists. Akron-
18 Peninsula Road averages a daily traffic count of about 2,300 motor vehicles; however, daily
19 traffic alone does not show the importance of the road for Blossom events and Cuyahoga Valley
20 National Parks access; and

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22 WHEREAS, the Village has a population of 565 people and does not have the tax base
23 for funding nor staff to repair the road, so the Engineer offered aid identifying and applying for
24 grants to get the road reopened; and

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26 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2021-130, authorizing the
27 Executive to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the Village of Peninsula concerning
28 the repair and relocation of Akron-Peninsula Road; and

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30 WHEREAS, the Engineer’s Office, on behalf of the Village of Peninsula, successfully
31 applied for \$1,000,000.00 in emergency funding from the Ohio Public Works Commission; and

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33 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2021-164, authorizing the
34 Executive to advertise for bids for the Akron-Peninsula Road Relocation Project, for an
35 estimated total cost not to exceed \$1,120,000.00; and

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37 WHEREAS, following the receipt and review of bids, the Executive has proposed
38 entering into a construction contract with Kenmore Construction Co., Inc. for the Akron-
39 Peninsula Road Relocation Project, in the Village of Peninsula, in Council District 1, in an
40 amount not to exceed \$717,574.00, with a 10% local cash match from the County in an amount
41 not to exceed \$71,757.40; and

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43 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on August 4, 2021, awarded a
44 construction contract with Kenmore Construction Co., Inc., as the lowest responsive and
45 responsible bidder, for the Akron-Peninsula Road Relocation Project, in the Village of Peninsula,
46 in Council District 1, in an amount not to exceed \$717,574.00, with a 10% local cash match from
47 the County in an amount not to exceed \$71,757.40, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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49 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
50 that the aforementioned construction contract with Kenmore Construction Co., Inc. for the

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4 Akron-Peninsula Road Relocation Project is necessary and in the best interest of the County of
5 Summit;

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7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
8 of Ohio, that:

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10 SECTION 1

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12 The award by the Board of Control of construction contract with Kenmore Construction
13 Co., Inc. for the for the Akron-Peninsula Road Relocation Project, in the Village of Peninsula, in
14 Council District 1, in an amount not to exceed \$717,574.00, with a 10% local cash match from
15 the County in an amount not to exceed \$71,757.40, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is
16 hereby authorized to execute said construction contract and any other necessary related
17 documents.

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19 SECTION 2

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21 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
22 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately
23 authorize a necessary construction contract for the relocation of Akron-Peninsula Road.

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25 SECTION 3

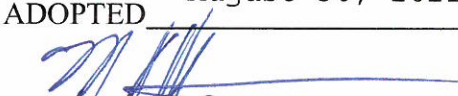
